Pray For Our National Leaders

Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our
Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

The Apostle Paul exhorts all believers to pray for our national leaders – “I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty. For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour; Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth” (1 Timothy 2:1-4). He further reminds us: “Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but of God: the powers that be are ordained of God” (Romans 13:1). Through the Prophet Jeremiah, God told the Israelites to pray for Babylon: “Seek the peace of the city whither I have caused you to be carried away captives, and pray unto the LORD for it: for in the peace thereof shall ye have peace” (Jeremiah 29:7).

Prayer is important. Prayer is powerful. God's Word is very clear. We are to pray for people in positions of authority such as government officials – international, national and local. We pray for the leaders of our country not only because we are commanded to, but because praying for them makes practical sense as well. It is a fact that our national leaders, their work, their integrity, and the decisions they make do affect the well-being of our country and the environment we live in. It has a great impact on the welfare of our families, our livelihood, our businesses, our churches, our schools and our work-places, not to mention our country's standing and reputation in the world. When leaders in authority obey the Will of God, we keep them in prayer, thankful that we will be able to “live a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty” (1 Timothy 2:2) under their

leadership. When evil men are in authority, our prayers for them are equally needed, trusting that God is in ultimate control.

Brethren, we pray for our national leaders not merely because good leaders will be to our benefit, but also because leadership can be a very exhausting task. Leaders have a duty and responsibility toward their followers. Leaders are the go-to people for help in a crisis. Leaders give their lives in service to the country and often are the target of criticism and ridicule. We pray God to guide and bless them because we recognize the tremendous load of their task and we are grateful for their willingness to lead. Pray also for their families who also have to bear the glare of public scrutiny as well.

How should we pray for our national leaders? First, if we are uncertain that they know Jesus, we should pray for their salvation. But whether or not our leaders are Christians, let us pray God to grant them wisdom, health and strength to resolve both national and international issues. As our national leaders are now having the heavy task of curtailing the spread of the Covid-19 in Singapore, let us as good citizens, encourage them by being socially responsible and abide by Government Advisories regarding keeping personal health hygiene habits, social distancing and consulting a doctor when not well.

Brethren, it is our duty to pray without ceasing for our national leaders. We pray God to have His way in the hearts of our country's leaders whom He has put in positions of authority, and use them mightily to bless our beloved nation, and all of us, the citizens, so that by God's grace and in His mercy, we may “lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty”. 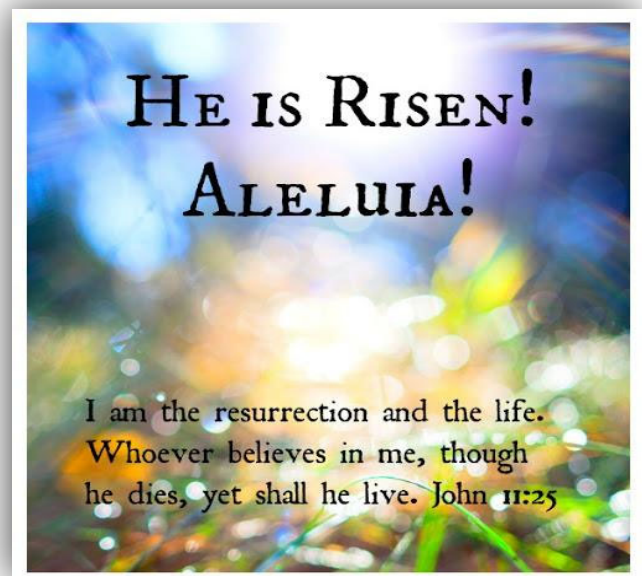
