GOD'S SUSTAINING GRACE

Galilee Church Bulletin, Lord's Day, 26 April 2020

Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Oftentimes when we talk about God's grace, we think about His saving grace. (Eph. 2:8-9 "For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.")

However, having God's grace is not only at the point of us coming to faith in Christ. We are thankful that God's grace sustains us through the whole journey of our Christian faith (Phil. 1:6 "Being confident of this very thing, that He (God) which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ"). God's sustaining grace does not mean that we are spared and immune from troubles in our lives. The Apostle Paul lived with a "thorn in the flesh" which he asked God three times to remove from him (2 Cor. 12:7-8). God did not remove this "thorn" from Paul but instead, God encouraged Paul that His grace, strength, and power are sufficient for him especially during tough times and times of weakness. This same assurance is also given us during difficult times in our lives.

When we have God's sustaining grace in our lives, we will be able to overcome the trials and temptations that come our way (1 Cor. 10:13 "There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, Who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it"). Secondly, we learn not to depend on our human strength and capabilities, but instead depend on God to keep us going for Him (Isaiah 41:10 "Fear thou not; for I am

with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of My righteousness"). Thirdly, God's sustaining grace ensures that we will rise above life's challenges with our faith in God much stronger (1 Peter 1:7 "That the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ").

Knowing that God's sustaining grace is always available to us as it was to the Apostle Paul, how then are we to have access to it?



Firstly, we need to have our primary focus on God and His Word – to direct our path in all seasons of our lives, especially the difficult

and tough-going ones. (Psalm 119:105 "Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path"). We seek comfort and encouragement in God's enduring promises given us in His Holy Word Focusing on God, Who is permanent and unchanging, will help us to stand firm in our faith and trust in Him all through life.

Secondly, we need to pray and seek God's sustaining grace and power in our lives (Heb. 4:16 "Let us therefore come boldly unto the Throne of Grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need"). When we do so, we will draw closer to God and be blessed by His Abiding Presence in our lives.

Brethren, let us commit to living lives that are filled with God's saving and sustaining grace.

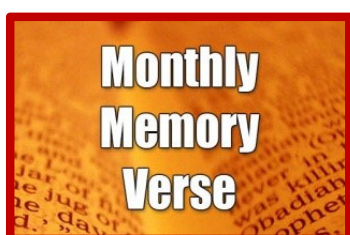
