Brethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. By God's grace, thus far, Galileans are kept safe from Covid-19. To God, be the glory! However, we cannot let our guard down. It is important we continue to abide by MOH Advisories to protect ourselves and others from infection.

How we miss our beautiful sanctuary @ Galilee! We can't wait to gather once again as one people, the church family, to worship our beloved Lord Jesus Christ. As "the deer panteth for the waters", we long to return to worshipping together, and to vibrant fellowship with one another in the Lord's House. And in God's good pleasure and time, we will.

Believers must engage in genuine, wholehearted worship of God. Spiritual Transformation is consequential to true worship. From time to time, it is crucial and profitable that we check ourselves: Do I attend Sunday Worship simply because I desire the respect of those in my community of faith? Do I attend church to please a particular person -- be it my parent, spouse, or child? Do I come to church because I want to see or be seen by some people? Am I motivated only by a sense of duty or habit? Let's be reminded that we come to Worship Service to revere, to adore, to glorify our Lord, and in obedience to the call to assemble in His House (Hebrews 10:25).

The Prophet Isaiah beheld the glory of the Lord "sitting upon a throne", and he worshipped the Lord with deep awe and reverence, his whole being riveted on God and God's commission for him. He was contemplative! As the earthly temple faded away, Isaiah was permitted to look into the Heavenly Throne Room. It dawned upon him that although the throne room of Judah was vacant, the throne of the universe was occupied by the Sovereign Creator God. Isaiah did not spend his time in the

temple, chatting with his acquaintances.

With a reverent and meditative spirit, he sought God in earnest, and God ministered to him.

Having caught a glimpse of the Perfect Holiness of God, Isaiah was overwhelmed by the depth of his own sin. He looked on, entranced; he saw angels hovering about the Lord, ready to do His bidding (Isaiah 6:2). He saw the fire of the Heavenly altar and heard the seraphims' song of adoration and praise to God (v.3). The sound of the Heavenly angelic choir pealed through the expanse, the pillars of the door shook to their foundations, and the temple was filled with smoke -- the reaction of God's Holy nature against sin. Isaiah's response to this majestic revelation of the Eternal God was an attitude of holy awe and deep repentance. He was vividly conscious of his own sinfulness and that of his people. With deep conviction, Isaiah confessed his spiritual uncleanness (6:5), that his "eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts". Brethren, there is no room for self-righteousness in our lives -- for all have sinned and come short of the glorify of God (Romans 3:23). Our "righteousness" is but like "filthy rags" (Isaiah 64:6). Why the stand-offish attitude! Why the pride!

Let's pray for a heart of "watchful, godly fear, a sensibility of sin, a pain to feel it near" (Charles Wesley), and humility to be quick to confess and make right with God (I John 1:9). Guilt and unconfessed sin can be most destructive in our spiritual life. This same truth also implies to mending "differences" in reconciliation with one another. Our Lord instructs — "...rememberest that thy brother hath ought against thee... go thy way; first be reconciled to thy brother, and then come and offer thy gift" (Matthew 5:24). It is also taught in the Lord's Prayer (Matthew 6:14). Brethren, may God help us to worship Him "in spirit and in truth" (John 4:24). Amen.

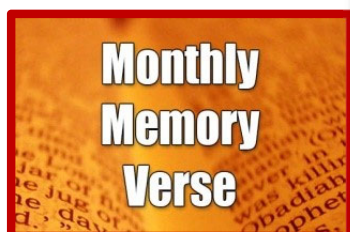
