WE ARE IMAGE-BEARERS OF GOD

Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the
Precious Name of our
Saviour and Lord Jesus Christ.

Of all the creatures in God's creation, we humans are the

only ones created in God's very image, after His likeness (Genesis 1:26). Whether Christians or not, we are all equal in dignity and worth in the sight of God; and we have all equally fallen and "come short of the glory of God" (Romans 3:23). Understanding our equality as imagebearers of God should cause us to view others in the way God views us. He views everyone either in Christ, or not in Christ.

There is no one on Planet Earth who is not in need of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. We are a part of humanity, each one of us heading toward either Heaven or Hell. It takes the mighty Power of the Gospel to save sinners (Romans 1:16) and transform an image-bearer's heart of stone to a "heart of flesh" (Ezekiel 36:26), bringing it to revere, worship and obey God, to the delight of God.

The Christian who has tasted the sweetness of having been forgiven by God of his sins will want to share with his fellow-men the Good News that "Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners" (1 Timothy 1:15). I thank God for not letting me perish in my sins. Though I had rejected the Gospel many times, the Lord was very patient with me. In His tender mercies, He saved me when I was at the verge of a mental breakdown. My salvation required His persistent pursuit. I was spiritually dead, but God made me alive through Jesus' Sacrificial Death on the Cross at Calvary. It was "the gift of God". I was made alive by grace through faith in Jesus Christ alone



(Ephesians 2:8-9). I could never have saved myself. I did not think then that my heart needed transformation but God knew what I needed. In God's Redeeming Grace, He sent a Christian to teach me

about God's gift of His Beloved Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, and how He died at Calvary to atone for my sins. Since the day God saved me, I have never regretted being a Christian. Even as I wrestle with the sins that so easily beset me, there remains in me a deep thirst for and yearning to see my Saviour and Lord face-to-face at His Return.

Transformed by God to be His image-bearers, we are changed from the inside out. That does not mean we are perfect. But, as we offer our bodies daily as "a living sacrifice" to God in worship, and have our minds renewed constantly by His Word (Romans 12:1-2), the Holy Spirit will help us conform to "the same image" of Christ in us, "from glory to glory" (2 Corinthians 3:18).

Christians are God's beautiful workmanship, His image-bearers, and His beloved children. We are, therefore, to love God "because He first loved us" (1 John 4:19) and gave His only Begotten Son to be a ransom for us (1 John 4:9). Brethren, as we relate to one another at home, at work, in church and in the community, especially during this Covid-19 Pandemic, may our lives shine forth for Christ and testify of what we know about our Eternal and Loving God to the people around us, such "that they may see our good works, and glorify our Father Which is in Heaven" (Matthew 5:16). All glory to God! Amen.


