# FIX OUR EYES ON JESUS, OUR BLESSED REDEEMER

eloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our
Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. We
need to have the right focus in life. If our focus
is on many different things, we will be
distracted and confused by many different
directions. It is also important not only to have
a single focus in life, but also the right one,
such that we are heading in the right direction.

What is this one thing or person that we as Christians are to look or fix our eyes on throughout life? Hebrews 12:2a tells us to look "unto Jesus the Author and Finisher of our faith". How do we keep our eyes on Jesus?



Firstly, God has given us His Holy Word, the Bible, to keep us along the right path. Psalm 119:105 -- "Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path". When we allow God's Word to direct our feet on the right path, it will perfect/mould all areas of our character to be more and more Christ-like. 2 Timothy 3:16-17 -- "All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works".

Secondly, we have the Blessed Holy Spirit to remind and guide us in God's ways. John 14:26 -- "But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in My Name, He shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you". When we walk the wrong way and go astray from God, the Holy Spirit will prompt and direct us back to the right path

to God. This is evident when we purpose to walk in the Spirit, and not in the flesh (Galatians 5:16-26).

Thirdly, we as fellow Christians are to encourage and keep one another accountable in our spiritual walk with God. This is especially important as we are living in the Last Days, and can easily be led astray by the deceitfulness of sin. Hebrews 3:13 -- "But exhort one another daily, while it is called To day; lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin". When we walk together in Christ, we will be able to stand strong together to walk through life.

What would result from having our eyes constantly focused or fixed on Jesus?

- We will be reminded that we are citizens of the Heavenly Kingdom, and our priorities must be toward the spiritual, rather than the earthly. Colossians 3:2 -- "Set your affection [minds] on things above, not on things on the earth". When we have Christ and His priorities in our minds, the decisions and directions we make will reflect Christ and bring glory to His Holy Name.
- We will be able to draw strength from Christ to walk well-pleasing to Him. With our Blessed Hope in Christ and His Heavenly Kingdom, we will be empowered by God to cope well the trials and difficulties that confront us. Romans 8:18 --"For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us".

Brethren, let us commit to live, God helping us, with our vision on the Cross @ Calvary, always focused and fixed on Christ, our Rock, our Strength, our Blessed Redeemer. Amen.
