#### WHAT CAN WE LEARN FROM THE HUMBLE TINY ANT?

Brethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ! Praise God for His marvellous favour and blessing on our little Island State, the Little Red Dot, for the last 55 years, and for sustaining us as one united people, facing the challenges of this unprecedented time of pandemic.

Next Sunday, 9 August, Singapore celebrates her 55th Birthday. Our founding fathers have left us a legacy of virtues, dedication in service and discipline that will continue to hold Singapore tall and robust to the admiration of many nations. I seek particularly to underline their readiness to take on challenges and steadfast grit and determination to work hard and persevere on, focused to accomplish their tasks. Industrious! I thought of the tiny ant that patrols our homes. According to the College Encyclopedia, there are some 2,000 species of ants in the world! Do you know that these little fellows are highly esteemed in the Scriptures? Prov 30:24 tells us that ants are "exceeding wise". "The ants are a people not strong, yet they prepare their meat in the summer" (v.24). What lessons can we learn from the humble ant?

Ants are organized and industrious. They travel long distances from their nests to gather food. The life of an ant is characterized by industry, diligence, sharing, planning and co-operation. In temperate lands, ants work hard before winter sets in. They are busy, busy, and forever busy. I read that the tiny ant is able to lift a particle 50 times its body weight. If a man works within that capacity, he can lift a small car! O No obstacles are too great for ants. They scale walls, swim over water puddles, crawl on the ceiling. and explore all nooks, even wall cracks, along their tracks. Prudence and forethought are commendable virtues that we can learn from the ant. Our Lord Jesus Christ Himself set the example of focus, commitment. diligence and urgency in our service for God: "I must work the works of Him that sent Me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work" (Jn 9:4). Brethren, we too must be diligent and faithful in our service for God, fully committed to the mission God has set for each of us as the Day approaches.

Ants have a short life-span. There is a **sense of urgency** in the way ants live and work. The survival of the entire ant colony depends on each and every ant's effort, and every ant is singly and fully devoted to that mission. I have not come across an ant sleeping or lazing somewhere along an ant trail. Have you? It seems that ants rest neither day nor night. The Bible teaches the slothful: "Go to the ant, thou sluggard; consider her ways, and be wise" (Prov 6:6). Brethren, our life on earth is short. "The days of our years are threescore years and ten; and if by reason

of strength they be fourscore years, yet is their strength labour and sorrow; for it is

soon cut off, and we fly away" (Ps 90:10). There is great urgency for us to do God's work well, and very importantly, to finish it well before the "night" falls. For us, "night" would mean death or the Return of our Lord Jesus Christ. Give of our best years, while strong and healthy, to our loving Saviour, not the years when we are riddled by physical weakness and debilitating illness (Eccl 12:1-6).

Like the ants, we should work hard before the "winter" of life sets in. Christians must guard against lethargy, idleness, slothfulness in our walk with and service for our Lord. Let us keep our vision and focus on the Cross of Jesus Christ, and not be distracted by the attractions of the world to blindly channel the main portion of our life, our time, effort and resources to the world. Take heed that sin will "derail" us from our "tracks" and cause us to squander away God-given opportunities to serve Him. Our Lord set the example for us during His three years of ministry on earth. He was committed to do the Father's Will, preaching the Good News, healing the sick, comforting the troubled, and ministering to the lost. Are we working hard to extend the Kingdom of God, ever-conscious of the urgency of the time, as the Day approaches?

A moving column of ants is fascinating to watch. I have not seen ants stop to have an angry exchange, a fist-fight or a wrestling match. Entomologists have recorded that when two ants come face-to-face, they use their antennae to "smell" each other, and after it is determined that both are nest-mates, they engage in a strange greeting ritual. This noticeable bond, unity and harmony in the ant's colony are worthy of emulation. How about us when we meet? May the simple joy of meeting one another be expressed in a warm greeting, a firm handshake (fist-bump during Covid!(2), asking after one another, encouraging and spurring each other unto good works for our Lord. An ant colony survives on a clear sense of mission, industry, harmony, unity and camaraderie -- So much we can learn here!

Brethren, should it be not so for us, the church family, bought by the Blood of the Lamb, one in the bond of our Saviour's love? We are exhorted to be diligent in service (Rom 12:11), with a sense of urgency (Jn 9:4). We are called to promote peace and harmony in the Body of Christ (Rom 12:18, Eph 4:3). Then, and only then, will the fruit of our labour in the Kingdom of God be abundant and sweet, acceptable and well-pleasing to our Lord. Amen.
