Don't Let Worry Rob Us Of Joy & Peace In The Lord

eloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our
Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

By definition, worry is excessive concern over real or anticipated danger due to uncertainty powerlessness. our One can take medication to relieve the symptoms of worry and anxiety, but one cannot remove the cause. One can purchase "sleeping pills" or "tranquility medication" at a drugstore, but one cannot purchase "rest" or "peace of mind" at any price. How can the Christian rise above the human tendency to worry, get anxious, even fearful -- in the midst of uncertainty, like what we are facing today because of the Covid-19 pandemic?

If our Lord Jesus wanted to worry, He had plenty of occasions to do so. Whilst here in this fallen world, Jesus was persecuted and in danger of being killed by the enemies of God. He knew that among the Twelve Disciples, one would betray Him for thirty pieces of silver (John 13:11). But our Lord did not succumb to anxiety. Instead, He prayed constantly and sought God the Father for grace and strength to see Him through. Likewise, in the midst of our struggles, may our confidence and trust in God, Who loves us and cares for us, remain steadfast, unshakable.

There is no reason for Christians to be overly "disturbed" by wicked people and their evil doings. We believe that God is sovereign and He is in control of all situations. As we continue to trust Him and walk closely with Him, we will be safe and secure in His loving arms. We also believe that God is able to see us through all situations in life. He is our Anchor and Refuge (Hebrews 6:19). The stronger the storm rages, the tighter the Lord holds on to us. And He will not let us go. We are precious in God's sight (Matthew 10:29-31).

Brethren, God loves us unconditionally. He cares and watches over us. He knows what we are going through. He will never leave or forsake us (Hebrews 13:5). Safety for the Christian is not the absence of danger or difficulties in life. Safety is knowing that God will take care of and deliver us through them all. Safety is in the Hands of our Almighty and compassionate God. So, let not worry "eat" us up till we become sick in body, in mind, in spirit and in soul. Let not fear rob us of the joy and peace we have in Christ Jesus.

Christians are not to dwell on, or "retreat" behind our worries and fears, not to look inward and fret, so much so that we do not see the Presence of God in our lives, even to lose the zeal to worship and serve Him. Let us pray God to help us use this time of in the midst of Covid-19 uncertainty, pandemic, to get closer to Him, to serve Him better and to witness for Him. It is during times like these, that the Gospel of Jesus Christ has to be told even more urgently to the unbelieving. Matthew 10:27 urges us to "preach [the Gospel] ...upon the housetops" so that more may hear it. Even as we guieten our pace, let not our zeal and effort in Witness & Evangelism for our Lord wane. There is so much we can do for the Lord to extend His Kingdom in all seasons. And if God so chooses to give us the privilege to die for His Kingdom's sake, we have not lived in vain, but in the grandest sense. It will be a life really worth living. "He is no fool who gives what he cannot keep to gain that which he cannot lose" - This is the conviction of evangelist Jim Elliot. Praise be to God!

Brethren, may our gracious Lord help us to remain true and loyal to Him all the days of our life. Meanwhile, stay prayerful, keep close to the Lord and be busy for Him. In times of plenty, and in times of lack, our business is to confess Christ before man. May God help us.
