Brethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ! By His mercies and grace, Galilean are kept safe from COVID-19 infection since the beginning of the pandemic. In every season of life, concerns and anxieties do show up at our door-step, one after another, non-stop. Sometimes, as the saying goes: "It never rains. It pours" -- remember the times we fretted over multiple cares at the same time? The reality is we live in an anxiety-ridden age, spinning along in a fast-paced world. If we do not know how to manage life stress and cope well with the cares of life, we can get easily discouraged, distressed, even depressed. Brethren, the precious Word of God encourages us when life's burdens are too heavy to bear -- **"Casting ALL your care [anxiety, worry, fear] upon Him; for He careth for you"** (1 Peter 5:7). There is enormous wisdom Scripture for our well-being. We are to surrender all, and cast the full weight of our care upon Jesus, our Lord, for He cares for us! How blessed we are, and what great comfort! We can hide safely in the Shelter of the Almighty in the time of storm.

There are two kinds of care in 1 Peter 5:7 -- **Our anxious care, and the Lord's affectionate care. First, let us look at "cast all your care."** The Greek understanding of care or anxiety is to have a divided mind or an anxious interest. The concept of a divided mind is to lose focus or to attempt to focus on too many things. Webster Dictionary defines anxiety as "a painful or apprehensive uneasiness of mind usually over an anticipated or impending situation or a strong fearful concern." George Mueller puts it aptly: **"The beginning of anxiety is the end of faith, and the beginning of true faith is the end of anxiety."** Anxiety is detrimental and of no benefit to our lives. Anxiety robs us of our joy in life. Anxiety steals our contentment. Anxiety erodes our confidence and causes us to fear. Anxiety steals our ability to trust God. Brethren, when anxiety assails us, remember this -- We have a God Who cares for

us and He invites us to cast **"ALL"** our care upon Him -- big or small, significant or trivial, spiritual or material. We get ourselves into trouble when we use our own "cleverness" to choose things we think we can handle on our own, do it our way, and things which we will commit to the Lord. Brethren, our Creator God Who holds and sustains the immensity of the universe, the splendour of the galaxy and the glorious beauty of nature in His Hands... and He says we are to commit our every care unto Him and trust Him to lead and guide us. Are we?

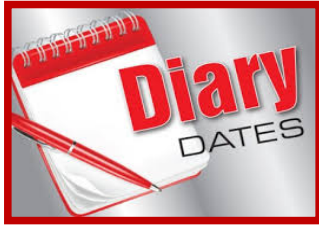
Next, we look at our Lord's tender, loving, gracious and compassionate care -- which we have all tasted of. Our Lord journeys with us through all of life's circumstances. He knows us and understands our every need, even our weaknesses, our strengths. When we are cumbered with a load of care, we can go to God our Refuge. He is waiting and He wants us to hand over to Him, all our fears, worries and anxiety. Not a part of it, not some of it, not most of it -- but **ALL** of it! Are we?

Brethren, why don't we do just that? God cares for for His own. He knows us better than we know ourselves. The same Mighty Hand that crafted the magnificent universe wants to craft our life for His glory. The same Voice that spoke light into existence is calling our names. The Creator of Heaven and Earth loves us and is concerned about us, and everything in our life. Isn't it amazing! Indeed, what a Friend we have in Jesus, all our sins, grief, and care to bear! COVID-19's spin-off affects us in many ways. Come to Jesus, our Shield, our Rock, and Comforter! We can confidently entrust our life into the Hands of our loving Heavenly Father, and abide in the Shelter of the Almighty. Trust and obey God. This is the only way.

God is worthy of our absolute trust. He can and He will take care of us right down to the smallest aspect of life, even our daily routine. All our tomorrows are secure in His Hands! Beloved children of God, rejoice and rest in the tender loving care of God. Anchor our Hope and Faith in God Who is Sovereign, Infinite in Wisdom, and Perfect in Love. He is able. Our Lord is able to lead us through Covid-19, through all of life, to the glory of His Holy Name. Thanks be to God! Amen.
