Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Through our recent pulpit sermons, we have been journeying with the Israelites as they went down into Egypt because of the famine, their hard labour at the hands of the Egyptians, and their journey out of Egypt to the Promised Land of Canaan. Throughout the entire journey, the Israelites had spiritual highs such as the Ten Plagues and their exodus out of Egypt, the miraculous parting of the Red Sea, and God's amazing daily provision of manna and quail as food for them. But they also had spiritual lows -- complaints first of lack of food and water, then grumbling about the constant diet of manna and quail, even worshipping the Golden Calf at the foot of Mount Sinai.

What are the lessons therein for us today? As pilgrims on our spiritual journey on this Earth (1 Peter 2:11-12), we too go through spiritual highs and lows in life due to our sinful nature. John Bunyan in his book "The Pilgrim's Progress" describes how sin and the related negative emotions of despondency, dejection and discouragement distract Pilgrim (the main character) from his goal of reaching the Celestial City. How then are we, as spiritual pilgrims, to keep our focus on God as we go through our spiritual highs and lows in life?

First, we must always remember, during our spiritual struggles, of God's faithfulness (2 Tim. 2:13 "If we believe not, yet He (God) abideth faithful: He cannot deny Himself"). We cannot rely solely on our limited human strength and abilities to bring us through life's challenges. In difficult times especially, we must all the more depend on and cling on to God, and our relationship with Him. As we

remain connected with the Vine, He will give us the courage and strength that He gave Moses and Joshua to lead the people of Israel to the Promised Land. (Joshua 1:5-6 "There shall not any man be able to stand before thee all the days of thy life: **as I was with Moses, so I will be with thee: I will not fail thee, nor forsake thee. Be strong and of a good courage:** for unto this people shalt thou divide for an inheritance the land, which I swore unto their fathers to give them"). Brethren, this is the Promise of God which holds true for us even today. The God that Moses and Joshua had is the same God Who walks beside us in our spiritual pilgrimage. Thanks be to God!

Second, let's be thankful and forget not God's continual blessings upon us -- whether in the past or the present. The Israelites experienced the miraculous works of God for themselves, but yet, they still grumbled and doubted God amidst their hardships, especially when they were trapped between the Red Sea and the Egyptian Army. Similarly, we are reminded that difficulties and hardships do come in all shapes and sizes in our lives which may cause us to doubt the Presence and goodness of God. It would do us well to recount how God has blessed and worked in our lives, and be thankful that He is walking with us daily, and will never forsake us (Deut. 31:6; Heb. 13:5).

Brethren, let us determine to walk closer with God, to get to know Him in a deeper relationship, and He will surely grant us grace, strength and power to live each day well for Him. (Isaiah 40:31 "But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary, and they shall walk, and not faint"). Amen.
