"WAIT on the LORD, and KEEP His way, and He shall EXALT thee" (Ps 37:34)

Brethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Lord and
Saviour Jesus Christ! A consequence of living in a
fast-paced world is that we lose our stamina to 'wait'
for anyone or anything. We want results quick, fast
and now. We have no time to wait. We hate to
queue at the bank, or wait for clearance at the
Customs Checkpoint, and we get really agitated
when caught in a traffic jam. The world we live in
celebrates quick speed and values fast, instant
satisfaction, quick-fix solutions. Sadly, this mindset
has crept subtly into our spiritual life. The Bible
teaches us repeatedly to wait patiently on God. But,
for many of us, that's a 'mammoth' challenge!

When we pray, we essentially present our petitions before God, seeking His favour for answers. Waiting on God begins after we have laid our petitions in prayer before God. As we pour our heart's burdens before God's Throne of Grace, we also seek refuge in God's Abiding Presence and Comfort, trusting that He, Who has heard our prayers, will answer them, according to His Will and in His own good time. It is true that sometimes we know not what we ask, but we can trust God to give us what He knows is best for us. The Psalmist exhorts: "Trust in Him [God] at all times; ve people, pour out your heart before Him: God is a refuge for us" (Ps 62:8). God's answer may be "Yes", "No" or "Wait". Even as we wait on God, especially for guidance and direction, we are exhorted to keep close to God and abide in Him and His way. "Truly my soul waiteth upon God: from Him cometh my salvation. My soul, wait thou only upon God: for my expectation is from Him" (Ps 62:1.5).

Waiting on the Lord is not being passive, not sit, wait, and do nothing. When we are worried, anxious, or impatient, and tired of waiting, we will probably just go ahead and do things our own way. It is in times like these that we must, all the more, saturate our hearts and minds with the assurances and comfort from God's Holy Word. "I wait for the LORD, my soul doth wait, and in His Word do I hope" (Ps 130:5). It is needful to dig deeper into God's Word during seasons of waiting on Him. Seek the Lord and pray unceasingly. Read His Word daily, study it devoutly and believe it wholeheartedly. God's Word is trustworthy. His promises are true. God's Word can "GPS" (God's Piloting System) us through times of difficulties, counsel us in our perplexity, steer us out of danger, comfort us in trouble and distress, and encourage and lift our spirit to look up

to Him. "Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path" (Ps 119:105). The Written Word must become for us, the Living Word, with the anointing of the Holy Spirit.

Brethren, after we have committed our heartaches and burdens to Him, let us wait prayerfully and patiently on the Lord. Are you praying for a loved one's salvation? Are you about to give up on someone that you concluded would never change for the better? Are you about to resign to the fact that your workplace will remain hostile towards you? Do you feel that your prayers are bouncing back from the ceiling? Brethren, don't despair! Do not be discouraged! Lift up your heart unto your loving Saviour Jesus Christ. We are "the apple of His eye" (Zech 2:8) and He cares for you and me. Keep close to God and His Word, and He will hold your hand and walk you through your trials with hope, courage and fortitude (Ps 23:4). "Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and He shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the LORD" (Ps 27:14)!



GALILEE B-P CHURCH REOPENING ENGLISH WORSHIP SERVICE

With effect from Lord's Day, Sept 20, 2020 8.30 am – 9.45 am (Church Sanctuary)

1. The Board of Elders/Session have decided to reopen Sunday EWS with effect from September 20, 2020, in the Church Sanctuary. The time is from 8:30 am to 9:45 am. Only 50 worshippers are allowed at each Worship Service as per the Ministry Of Health Advisory. Worshippers are required to individually reserve a place in the Sanctuary to participate in the Worship Service through the booking system on the Galilee Website. Children also require registration.

To let everyone have equal opportunity to attend Worship Service in Church, worshippers should register for only one on-site Service each month, until the Government allows more attendees in each gathering.

- 2. Weekly Worship Service will be broadcasted live on the Internet and remains available on the Galilee Website for subsequent viewing for a reasonable period.
- 3. The Church observes Holy Communion on the first Sunday of each month.
- 4. With effect from September 20, 2020, Galilee Mandarin Worship Service is from 10:30 am to 11:45 am, in Room 03-01.
- 5. Sunday School remains unchanged on Zoom for the time being.
