GOD GIVETH A SOUND MIND

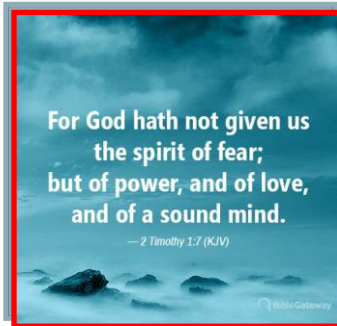

Brethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ! One great blessing that God has graciously bestowed upon His people is... **the blessing of a sound mind.** A sound mind is vital in Christian living. God's people must be clear and focused on God and God's

truth, otherwise we will be confused, distracted by false teachings, and be led astray. Sound thinking is essential because it leads to correct living. The heart carries our emotions and feelings, whereas the mind is the seat of our thoughts, thinking, imaginations, comprehension and reasoning logic. Having a sound mind is important -- because everything we do, every decision we make and every action we take -- comes from the perception and comprehension of our mind. We must be vigilant and be on constant guard that we do not let our mind be diseased by sin, or let it be contaminated by the world, to turn eccentric or tainted with delusive fancies. When our mind is stained by sin, folly, pride, self-will, unrepentance and disobedience to God, the consequences will be dire, bringing fear, disorder and suffering upon self and our loved ones, even to the people around us.

The Apostle Paul reminds us: **"God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind"** (2 Tim 1:7). He is not speaking of having a sound mind in natural things. Valuable as this may be, but ultimately, it is only a temporal gift. Paul is referring to God's spiritual grace -- the blessing of a sound mind anchored steadfastly in God and the whole counsel of His Holy Word -- given us together with the empowerment of God's Holy Spirit and in His perfect love. "There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear" (1 Jn 4:18).

Brethren, we, who know the truth of God, are a people of sound mind – set free from fear and the bondage of superstition, vindictiveness,



malice, fanaticism, wild imaginations and delusive fancies. The transforming Power of the Gospel's redemptive grace and the Eternal Word of God work in God's people to trust and obey Him, to exercise a sound mind to discern truth and falsehood, right and wrong, and not be swayed by every passing whim

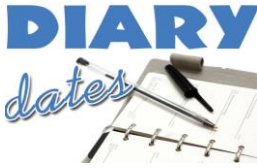
of fancy; to have steadfast and unwavering faith in God, and not be deceived by every novel false doctrine; or be charmed by every alluring device of the Wicked One and be trapped by his flesh-pleasing snares; or be easily swayed by man's wicked ways. A people of sound mind exercises sobriety of judgment, godly discipline and holy wisdom in the things of God, with fixedness of heart upon the Lord Jesus and be led by Him. Brethren, when we cast **"down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ"** (2 Cor 10:5), God's Spirit and grace will free us from fear and keep us from error and delusion. The Only Wise God our Saviour leads us into paths of righteousness for His Name's sake.

Where there is **a sound mind**, there will also be **a sound faith, a sound hope, a sound love, a sound repentance, and a sound work of grace.** A sound mind is deeply and vitally imbued with the truth of God, and is obedient to live it out. God's truth endures forever, and those who know it for themselves are truly the blessed people of God. They who have **"the mind of Christ"** (1 Cor 2:16) know and handle aright all things and circumstances, natural and spiritual, to the glory of God. Amen.

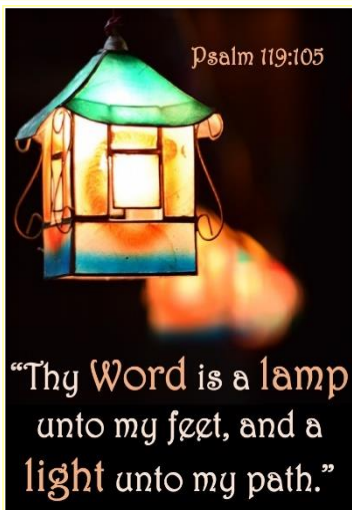

1. The Board of Elders/Session have decided to reopen Sunday EWS with effect from September 20, 2020, in the Church Sanctuary. The time is from 8:30 am to 9:45 am. Only 50 worshippers are allowed at each Worship Service as per the Ministry Of Health Advisory. Worshippers are required to individually reserve a place in the Sanctuary to participate in the Worship Service through the booking system on the Galilee Website. Children also require registration.

To let everyone have equal opportunity to attend Worship Service in Church, worshippers should register for only one on-site Service each month, until the Government allows more attendees in each gathering.

2. Weekly Worship Service will be broadcasted live on the Internet and remains available on the Galilee Website for subsequent viewing for a reasonable period.
3. The Church observes Holy Communion on the first Sunday of each month.
4. With effect from September 20, 2020, Galilee Mandarin Worship Service is from 10:30 am to 11:45 am, in Room 03-01.
5. Sunday School remains unchanged on Zoom for the time being.
