# STRENGTHEN THE INNER MAN

# eloved Brethren,

Greetings in the Precious Name of our Saviour and Lord Jesus Christ. Have we ever given much thought to how we respond when someone asks how we are doing? We almost always associate this question with the physical, and our normal instantaneous reply is a quick: We are doing well; or we are fine; or we are not doing well; or we are not feeling good [physically]. We tend to respond with the physical in mind. It is rare indeed when someone skips the physical, the outer man, and speaks of the [spiritual] condition of the inner man in response.

How often, if ever, do we ask others: "Is it well with your soul?" How often do we inquire of our Christian brethren and closest friends about their devotion life, their prayer life, and their overall spiritual well-being? Not often enough, I am afraid. And yet these things [the spiritual welfare of a person] are important, yea, more important than the physical condition of God's children. Our spiritual health requires our continual and diligent attention to keep it in good shape.

I would rather be spiritually fit than physically fit alone. Certainly, we are to take care of the body that God has given us, but the body is going to age, fail, get sick, and eventually pass on. We are not to "hurry" the process along with foolish, careless and indulgent living, but rather, we are to be responsible to take care of our physical health, as God willing, we want to have strong bodies and physical vigour to serve our Lord well. The truth is, the outer man will perish one day. Our spiritual fitness is more important than our physical fitness because the inner man will never die. To attain spiritual fitness and vitality, we must be diligent to strengthen and renew the "inward man" day by day.

How then do God's people strengthen the inner man? We are what we "feed" on spiritually. In order for the inner man to be renewed and revitalised every day, we must feed on all that is spiritually healthy. It is not enough just to read the Word of God, memorize it, or even study in depth the Word of God. We need to meditate upon the Word of God and spend quiet, reflective time in the sweet Presence of the Lord. The Word of God must be woven intricately into the very fabric of our lives and applied in our daily practical living. Have you not found that the more we meditate on God's Word and the more time we spend in the Presence of God, the closer to Him we get, the more conformed to the image of God's only Begotten Son we become, and the more holy and sanctified we will be? We grow in a deeper relationship with God.

As we come into the Presence of God in prayer, the Holy Spirit will convict us of our sins, and as we confess our sins to God, He foraive and of all will cleanse us unrighteousness (1 Jn 1:9,7). If God's people were to occupy themselves with the mundane things of the world and focus on the temporal, it is not surprising that they will imbibe an earthly view of things, and neglect the things eternal. In addition to meditation on God's Word, God's people must be given to much even fasting, sometimes prayer, over extended periods of time.

Persevering prayer, wrought from the very souls of our hearts, goes up to God the Father Who hears us, Who understands and Who cares for us. God speaks to us when we meditate upon His Word and as we respond in prayer, the Holy Spirit Who indwells us will strengthen our inner man (Eph 3:16). This, my brethren, is the blessing of being strong in the Lord. It lifts our spirits and gives us resilience in the Lord to face difficult times. It keeps us rejoicing in hope in the Lord, patient in affliction and persevering in prayer. The Psalmist's strength is in the Lord: "My flesh and my heart faileth: but God is the strength of my heart, and my portion forever" (Ps 73:26). Ours too, we pray.

Thanks be to God. Amen.

# GALILEE B-P CHURCH REOPENING ENGLISH WORSHIP SERVICE With effect from next Lord's Day, Sept 20, 2020 8.30 am – 9.45 am (Church Sanctuary)

1. The Board of Elders/Session have decided to reopen Sunday EWS with effect from September 20, 2020, in the Church Sanctuary. The time is from 8:30 am to 9:45 am. Only 50 worshippers are allowed at each Worship Service as per the Ministry Of Health Advisory. Worshippers are required to individually reserve a place in the Sanctuary to participate in the Worship Service through the booking system on the Galilee Website. Children also require registration.

To let everyone have equal opportunity to attend Worship Service in Church, worshippers should register for only one on-site Service each month, until the Government allows more attendees in each gathering.
