Lord's Day, 1 November 2020

Brethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ!
Several dear brethren went through, in recent months, very challenging times of health issues. As the church family persevered in prayer before God's Throne of Grace, our Lord graciously and mercifully enabled our brethren to press on through medical tests and treatments, with courage and unflinching trust in God. As we get on in life, "repairs" to our ageing physical bodies are to be expected. However, one thing we must do, to pray unceasingly for healing and God's mercy, encouraging our brethren scheduled for surgical procedures, recovering from post-operations, currently under medical care for ailments, coping with pre-existing health conditions. Always keep one another in prayer.

When health weakens, physical suffering is inevitable and various restraints are necessary to assist the healing process. In such times, not surprisingly, we may become emotionally discouraged, stressed, even disheartened spiritually as anxiety sets in. We wonder: What's God's Plan for my ailment? How long -- when will the Lord deliver me from my suffering? And God forbid: Is this a form of retribution for my iniquities? On the hospital bed, staring at the chalk-white ceiling, such worrisome thoughts well up naturally in our hearts. This is the time to seek earnestly the Lord for grace and strength to see us through.

Give thanks and pray God to help us remember that our God is all-powerful, ever-loving and protective over us, yet in His Sovereign and Perfect Will, He permits trials, ailments and adversity in life's way. In God's Unflinching Love and Perfect Wisdom, He has equipped each of us with spiritual grit and stamina, physical resources and mutual support in the Body of

Christ, to rise above life's tough times. Through it all, God shapes our spiritual formation to grow closer to Him.

Our Lord Jesus is the Great Physician Who heals in His Perfect Will as we look up to

Him in faith. He took the Apostle Peter's mother-in-law by her hand, helped her up and her fever instantly fled (Mk 1:30-31). The woman with the issue of blood said to herself: "If I may touch but His clothes, I shall be whole" (Mk 5:28).

The Apostle Paul underlined this Biblical truth - - "We have not a High Priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities" (Heb 4:15). Our Lord feels our pain, understands our anxiety, is ever patient with our murmurs. How did Jesus respond to Martha's sorrow in John 11:33 -- "When Jesus, therefore, saw her weeping, and the Jews also weeping which came with her, He **groaned (deeply moved) in the spirit, and was (greatly) troubled**". Our Lord journeys with us every step of our way (Ps 23:4). He is not a bystander. He identifies with us, His beloved brothers and sisters, for whom He laid down His life and secured eternal salvation for us. When the Jerusalemites suffered a lack of sound leaders, "Jesus wept" (Jn 11:35). Our Lord's heart went out for the widow of Nain, who lost her only son -- "Don't cry" (Lk 7:13). Such comfort from our Lord! Our loving, compassionate Saviour is touched by our infirmities and pain. He underwent suffering and pain for our sakes, for our salvation. Give thanks always for God's Everlasting Love, His Abiding Presence, His Enabling Power and His Perfect Purpose in every aspect of our lives. Amen.
