## HAVING A LASTING LOVE FOR GOD

Galilee Church Bulletin, Lord's Day, 22 November 2020

**B**eloved Brethren,  
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Before COVID-19 hit the world and became a pandemic, we could have been caught up with many earthly commitments -- our careers, our studies, our families, our life ambitions and goals, etc. We could also have taken for granted our weekly church gatherings on Wednesday nights and Sunday morning Worship, church activities and fellowship. Months into COVID-19 Phases of gradual re-opening of our economy, we would have taken time to reflect on the importance of having a lasting love for God.

Despite the scientific and medical advancements that we have seen and read about in this world, we are still reminded of how vulnerable and transient life is. No matter how important our earthly commitments, achievements and successes seem to us, let us remember that our spiritual commitment to God must always be first in our lives, and is the one thing that will last beyond our earthly lives to all eternity. Listen to the Apostle Paul's conviction: "For to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain" (Phil. 1:21).

Our love for God and for one another should not be a mere momentary and emotional response, but an intentional volitional response of our human will. It is not in our natural human nature to love God and others, but we have to intentionally set our minds to do so (Matt. 22:37-39). This is because our human inclination is self-centered and loving ourselves first, often neglecting God and others. 1 John 2:15-17 warns that loving the world with lust of the flesh, lust of the eyes, and the pride of life will distract us from doing the eternal Will of God, to love God and others. So, let us always draw nigh to God, and He will be near to us (James 4:8).

Oftentimes, we consider church attendance and involvement in church activities as a good measure of how a person is doing in his spiritual walk and in his relationship with God. It is important that we go beyond external spiritual practices to develop our inner heart attitudes and personal spiritual disciplines toward God. A close daily walk with God will sustain us through life on earth. Paul testified: "And he [Jesus] said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for My strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me" (2 Cor. 12:9).

A healthy inner spiritual heart condition will express itself in external spiritual practices and



gatherings with our fellow-Christians. We need not walk and struggle on our own; we encourage and strengthen one another (Heb. 10:24-25 "And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the Day approaching").

Brethren, let not our hearts and minds be caught up with many earthly commitments and chasing after the things of this world. By God's grace and the empowerment of the blessed Holy Spirit, let us live always to have a spiritual emphasis on and priority to love God and the brethren. It pleases God as we do so, even as we strive to be lasting shining lights and ambassadors for God in a fallen world. Amen.
