WORSHIPPING GOD THROUGH PRAISE

Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless His Holy Name. Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits. Ps 103:1-2

rethren, Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ! Praise God in the Forest! Imagine we spend worshipful time in one of our beautiful forest reserves, sit on a bench, close our eves, tune in to the Forest Symphony Orchestra and enjoy the multi-dimensional sound field that engulfs our auditory sensory. The crickets, cicadas and a myriad of insects hum praises to their Creator amidst the luscious flora in their full glory. With the sun peeping through the tree-tops, the breeze swaying gently among the leaves, the gurgling crystal-clear brooks, the trickling tingle of waters from somewhere among the rocks, the rhythmic flow of spring waters into little streams, the forest is alive with the pure sound of music, day and night, all in majestic praise to the glory of God! Multi-coloured birds chirp merrily from the tree-tops; even the macagues' distinctive sharp calls have a rightful place in nature's symphony of praise. One can almost hear the crisp crush of dry twigs and leaves on the ground as squirrels and monitor lizards scuttle by. As nature and creatures chorus praise in the surrounds, peace fills our soul and our spirit soars in wonder and adoration to our Maker. With nature's majestic orchestra in play, the warmth of God's Love and Presence embraces us ever so closely. "This Is My Father's World" invites the whole of God's creation in nature to serenade praises to our Creator God (Ps 148:1-10). Hallelujah!

God has created man for His good pleasure.

How are we praising our Maker? The very first teaching in the Westminster Shorter Catechism is: The chief end of man is to glorify God and to enjoy Him forever. We have been spontaneous in glorifying God through praise from grateful hearts, in words and song. This year, the COVID-19 pandemic has put every perceivable system and people to almost breaking point. Almost 1.4 million people around the world had lost their lives to Covid-19. Thank God for an able, wise and agile-thinking government in Singapore that works tirelessly to care for us and the migrant workers benevolently. Webster defines "praise" as "to say good things about", synonymous with "admire, commend, extol, honor and worship". Yes, Christian praise is worship -- the joyful expression of thanksgiving and adoration to God, the celebration of God's goodness, mercies and grace in our lives. The Psalmist exhorts us to "Praise the Lord!" thirteen times in joyous praise and worship (Ps 150).

Why is praising God so important? Countless reasons there are, but the main one is that the



Almighty God, the Creator of Heaven and Earth, is worthy to receive our praises: "For the LORD is great, and greatly to be praised" (Ps 96:4). "Great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised; and His greatness is unsearchable" (Ps 145:3). "Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for Thou hast created all things, and for Thy pleasure they are and were created" (Rev 4:11). As we praise God, we gain a deeper understanding of the greatness of our awesome God, His Power and Presence in our lives. As we acknowledge Who God is, we are reminded of who we are. "What is man, that Thou art mindful of him? and the son of man, that thou visitest him? (Ps 8:4). Physical exercise is good for our heart. Praising God continually is crucial to strengthen our spiritual heart, to keep it beating strong for God. "Let everything that hath breath praise the LORD. Praise ye the LORD" (Ps 150:6).

Praise God even in Adversity. It is easy to sing praises to God when all is going well in life. During times of trouble and suffering, do we praise God just as enthusiastically? No, we tend to murmur and complain. Brethren, as we mature in our Christian faith, we will praise God even in adversity, for we are thankful that God's love, goodness and power are new every morning! Do you know that many great hymns of praise were penned in tears, by people facing challenging calamities, in suffering?

What blessings come with praising God? Praising God humbles the human soul, putting man right back where we belong -- the created creatures worshipping the Creator God. Praising God reminds us of our identity in Christ, our God-given privileges, and our duty before God. Praising God nurtures hearts thankful for God's grace, goodness and peace. Praising God strengthens us to live for God in holiness and consecration. When we focus on God in praise and worship, He ministers to us, and the things of the world become strangely dim. Praising God helps us to recount the bountiful blessings of God in our lives. Praising God reminds us of God's wonderful Redemption and Salvation in Christ Jesus. Brethren, how not to keep praising the Lord!

Praise the Lord! Hallelujah! Praise the Lord! Paskor Simon N.




