
Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious
Name of our Saviour and
Lord Jesus Christ.

We all struggle with the issue of trust, don't we? "Trust no one but self" is such that we want to be in full control, to take charge and make sure that our interests are well taken care of and secure. The word "trust" means "worthiness of being believed on; a resting on the

integrity, friendship, etc of another..." (Chambers 20th century Dictionary). So, the person we are going to trust has to be one who has impeccable character traits of honesty, fairness, truthfulness, integrity, justice, morality, ethics, and consistency. By this time, we would be thinking, "No way! No one and nothing is that trustworthy! I cannot take the risk. I better trust myself". It is true there were times our trust has been misplaced and we suffered the consequences. There were also times when we ourselves have failed to fulfill the trust that others have placed in us, and we let them down. May God help all of us.

Scripture tells us that God, our loving Heavenly Father is absolutely trustworthy. We can trust God without reservation in every aspect of life. He never forsakes us. When we trust God with all our problems, pain and hurt, He will sustain us and give us the grace and strength to rise above it all. Pray God for faith to believe that "all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to His purpose" (Rom 8:28). Our Sovereign God is trustworthy. Where God leads, we cannot fall.

My brethren, there is no stronger Defence for us than our Almighty and Faithful God. We can trust the Divine One Whose character attributes are love. compassion, righteousness, honesty, faithfulness, steadfastness, truthfulness and justice. God our Heavenly Father is holy, ethical, and consistent. He unfaltering. is He is

May I remind all of us that trusting God also calls for obedience on our part to do what is right and pleasing in His Holy sight. Psalm 37:3-6 encapsulates it all: "Trust in

Commit thy way unto the Lord; trust also in Him; and He shall bring it to pass. And He shall bring forth thy righteousness as the light, and thy judgment as the noonday". **Trust and Obey** – This is the path of blessedness for God's children.

I have learned from my own life experiences that there is freedom, joy and peace in trusting our Sovereign and Faithful Lord. It has not been an easy journey for me but the Abiding Presence and the Precious Word of God have sustained me, and will continue to do so. I would like you, my beloved brethren, to know and enjoy this freedom, joy, rest and peace for yourself.

In God we trust. On the Solid Rock we stand. May I urge you to take the leap of faith and trust in God! Through the "waters, rivers, and fires" – you will find God faithful and true. Amen.
