
Prethren,
Greetings in the Precious
Name of our Lord and Saviour
Jesus Christ.

Today is Dedication Sunday @ Galilee Church. Year after year, it has been our good tradition where Galileans come before our Heavenly Father, Christ our Saviour and Lord, to solemnly pledge our commitment to

serve Him faithfully for yet another year with the gifts imparted to us by the Holy Spirit (1 Cor 12:11). An oath in God's sight is a serious matter. The oath we take before God today, we must fulfil it wholeheartedly, without wavering (Duet 23:21; Ps 76:11; Eccl 5:4). Our Lord is displeased when an oath is taken lightly or insincerely (Matt 5:33-37).

We are gifted to serve! In the Old Testament days, God selected gifted people and tasked them to construct the physical Tabernacle with their Godgiven skills. God's instructions were specific: "Every wise hearted (skilled or gifted) man among them that wrought the work of the Tabernacle made ten curtains of fine twined linen, and blue, and purple, and scarlet: with cherubims of cunning work made he them" (Ex 36:8). Exodus 31 tells us that God placed craftsmen according to their gifts, given as He wills, and enhanced them with wisdom, skill and knowledge to accomplish the tasks assigned.

Thank God for blessing our beloved Church with people of differing skills, experiences, knowledge and training to serve together for the extension of His Kingdom. The church leadership serving together with Galileans in the various church Ministries, Departments, Fellowship Groups and Small Groups pleases the Lord. The Apostle Paul put it straight to the Corinthians: "Now concerning spiritual gifts, brethren, I would not have you ignorant..." (1 Cor 12:1). The Blessed Holy Spirit gives distinctively different gifts (12:7) and equips and empowers the believers to serve God where He has placed them. The same God inspires and energizers His beloved people in service, not for self-benefit. We are gifted to serve!



In the Parable of the Talents (Matt 25:14-30), before the master set off on a business trip, he called his servants together and gave them talents according to their abilities (v.14). The servants had no clue when their master would return from his trip; neither did he give step-bystep instructions as to where,

when and how they should invest the talents entrusted to them. The servants had a free hand to exercise their discretion, wisdom, best judgement to do what is good to please their master.

Brethren, whichever ministry God has placed us to serve at Galilee, may God help us to be good and faithful stewards to exercise our God-given gifts and talents to edify the Body of Christ, to the glory of God (1 Pet 4:10,11). One thing is sure, we must not "bury" our gifts (Matt 25:18) as they are of God and given to us for a purpose. Pray God for wisdom to position our gifts in the right place for maximum Kingdom value. I thank God that you have prayerfully considered where and how to serve in the Galilee family. As you dedicate yourself in consecration unto the Lord today, may you exercise your gifts responsibly, in loving ministry to each other, to the glory of God. Man may applaud our effectiveness in service as God's gifts operate through us, but we must all remember this: "So likewise ye, when ye shall have done all those things which are commanded you, say, We are unprofitable servants: we have done that which was our duty to do" (Luke 17:10). Our gifts are like tools in the workers' hands, not shining badges of honour to pin proudly on our jackets for people to see. Service for God is a joy, a privilege, a responsibility – not to be taken lightly. We serve the King of kings, the Lord of lords because we love Him. God helping us, the Galilee family dedicates today to serve God wholeheartedly, cheerfully, with pure and humble hearts, in thanksgiving for His love for us which endures forever.
