FULFILING THE MISSION OF GOD

Galilee Church Bulletin, Lord's Day, 24 January 2021

Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our
Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. God
sent His Beloved Begotten Son Jesus Christ to
die on the Cross for our sins, was buried and
raised on the third day so that we can be
brought from darkness into the light of His
Kingdom. As God has sent His Son into the
world, we are also sent by God into the world
to fulfil His mission of Kingdom work (John
20:21 "Then said Jesus to them again, Peace
be unto you: as My Father hath sent Me, even
so send I you.").

The ongoing COVID-19 pandemic has certainly reworked refreshed and our understanding and concept of what church is and our role in the mission of God in the world. We should certainly not be satisfied with merely remaining in Galilee Church, and inviting and expecting people to come to us to have the hearing of the Gospel for them. This would be a physical location-focused concept of church which COVID-19 has certainly managed to undermine, with physical church gatherings of His people being initially made inoperative and we were initially restricted to online platforms and fellowship. Thus, we should not only restrict our understanding of church to be that of a physical gathering but extend it to include the spiritual meaning and significance of church.

We as a spiritual body of believers are truly connected through our saving faith in our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ to a restored relationship with God our Heavenly Father (Eph. 4:4-6 "⁴ There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; ⁵ One Lord, one faith, one baptism, ⁶ One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all"). Having this spiritual connection in Christ

means that we are not to restrict ourselves within the four walls of our church building. Instead, our physical presence as well as our spiritual influence and significance need to be in society too. Individually and together we are God's ambassadors and His representatives scattered throughout our national society in one way or the other. This is surely God's purpose for equipping us (Eph. 4:12 "For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the Body of Christ") to be sent out into the world (John 20:21) and also the Great Commission (Matt. 28:18-20).

In 1527, when the bubonic plague was spreading in Wittenberg, Germany, Martin Luther's superior, John wanted to move him and his fellow professors from Wittenberg to another town Jena for their safety. But Luther chose to remain in Wittenberg to provide his ministerial presence and service. Luther's advice to a pastor in another German city of Breslau hit by this same bubonic plague was to know the risks in staying put, use medicine in times of need, keep away from others when not well, and be more steadfast knowing the greater importance of an enduring Christian ministry. Luther concludes "Whoever will not help or support another person unless they can do it without affecting their safety or property will never help their neighbour."

Let us not allow the health and economic risks of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic to restrict our ministry to one another as well as to others in society. Instead, we should press on together with the additional use of technology and other creative means to have a connected, engaged and relevant ministry (John 10:11-12) to the glory of God. May God grant us His wisdom and strength to always stay engaged in His mission in this world. Amen.
