Nurturing A Healthy Thought Life Galilee Church Bulletin, Lord's Day, 14 February 2021

Beloved Brethren, Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

Our thought life is something we must take charge of, for if we do not, it will control us. Christians need to be intentional about what we are to focus our thoughts on, what

we feed our minds with. Nurturing a healthy thought life is important for what we occupy our minds with... that we will become, that we will do. Proverbs 23:7 reminds us: "For as he thinketh in his heart, so is he..." So true.

Knowing how quickly a listless mind will tune into the things and attractions of the world, the Apostle Paul guides us to think aright - "Brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things" (Phil 4:8). Let us take a closer look at Paul's list of things. First, things that are 'true". For us Christians, it is important that we understand that our standard for what is true is based absolutely on the Word of God. God's Word is Truth. In order to be able to discern truth from falsehood, we need to walk closely with God and know His Word well. Sadly, in today's culture, truth can be relative. It is scary when there are no absolutes, no clear right and wrong. People seem to be more concerned with "feeling good" than what is true. Indeed, many are subtly led astray because they could not discern truth anymore. A person facing problems in marriage may think like and do as the world does -"I deserve better than this. Not fair to me. I should just get out and move on". To harbour such a thought, the person may have fallen into the "victim" mentality of society and end up taking a "quick exit" via a divorce. But a person who has God in his mind and heart, knows there is forgiveness and reconciliation.

As a man thinketh in his heart 80 he is.... Proverbs 237

The Christian's "road-map" in life is the Bible, the Holy Word of God. If we are not grounded in the truth of God's Word, our thinking can easily go the wrong way and our conduct that stems from wrong thinking will also be wrong. Let us learn from the Berean Christians how we ought to exercise our minds: "...with all readiness of mind, and searched the Scriptures daily,

whether those things were so" (Acts 17:11). The whole counsel of God in the Bible is good for every aspect of our daily life. Are we serious about putting time and effort to study and keep God's Word in our minds and hearts?

Paul then urges us to think on things that are honest, things that are dignified and sacred as opposed to those things that are profane and wicked. We are to think on things that are **just**, that is, do things right with a clear conscience and be fair. We are to think on things that are **pure**, things that are wholesome, not morally impure, unadulterated. We are to think on things that are lovely, things kind and gracious which promote peace rather than cause conflict and disunity. We are to think on things that are of good report, things that are highly respected, that bear good testimonies for Christ, even in the eyes of the non-Christians. In fact, we are called to think on things that carry virtues and are praiseworthy. It is true if the things we think have **virtue**, we will be motivated to do better; and if there be **praise**, we will see worth in commending them to others.

Brethren, we need to guard our mind from imbibing the evil influences of the world so that we will not dwell on the wrong kinds of things, do wrong things, which will lead us away from Christ. We must consciously renew and fill our minds with the sanctifying Word of God. Let us take every thought captive to the obedience of Christ (2 Cor 10:5) and seek the Lord daily to help us meditate on things that are true, honest, just, pure, lovely, of good report, virtuous and praiseworthy. Let us be stable and steady Christians, to the praise and glory of our God and Saviour Jesus Christ. Amen.
