BLESSED TO BE A BLESSING

Galilee Church Bulletin, Lord's Day, 28 February 2021

Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. We have celebrated the fifteenth and last day of our Chinese New Year, also commonly known as “*Chap Goh Meh*”. On this day, some traditional Chinese families come together to celebrate it and, at the same time, remember the unity and blessings on the family.

While we remember our physical blessings during this Chinese New Year, it should also remind us of the greater spiritual blessings of a more meaningful and fruitful relationship with God. God has promised such spiritual blessings to those who would faithfully walk with Him in obedience (Ps. 119:1 “Blessed are the undefiled in the way, who walk in the law of the Lord”; Eph. 1:3 “Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ”). How then would we be guided in our undefiled or faithful walk with God?

Psalm 1 reminds us to be very mindful of our attitude toward God's Word. Ps. 1:1 “Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful” tells us of 3 degrees of association with the ungodly [sinners, scornful]. Firstly, we are not to walk or conform our ways and patterns of thinking to follow in their sinful ways and actions. Secondly, we are not to stand or develop our forms and habits such that they become more and more firmly entrenched in the ways of the world. Lastly, we are not to sit or be seen in the same company as those who scorn or look down on God and His Word. Instead, Ps. 1:2 “But his delight is in the law of the Lord; and in His law doth he meditate day and night” tells

us that we must develop our love, delight, and desire in focusing on God's Word.

To develop our love for God's Word, we must cultivate our daily spiritual habit of reading and meditating on it. 2 Tim. 3:16-17 tells us that “All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works”. God's Word can certainly shape our spiritual lives if we willingly and whole-heartedly submit to it.

Being firmly rooted in God's Word, we would then experience three main spiritual benefits. **The first** is that we would have spiritual stability (verse 3a – “a tree planted by the rivers of water”). **The second** is that we would have good lasting spiritual fruits in our lives (verse 3b – “bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither”). These spiritual fruits can either refer to the different aspects of our godly character that God has brought about in our lives, or the precious souls that God has used us to bring unto His Kingdom. **The third** is that we would also be successful and experience God's blessings in and through the whole process (verse 3c – “whatsoever he doeth shall prosper”), and then extend them to others in our lives.

Simply put, our minds must be focused on God, His Word, and His blessings, so that it would be stable and not rocked by the crises that come into our lives (Isaiah 26:3 “Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on Thee: because he trusteth in Thee”).
