Brethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Today, is Missions Sunday! The Lord has commissioned the church "Go ye into all the world, and preach the Gospel to every creature" (Mk 16:15). The Disciples "went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them..." (16:20). We too are responsible to do missions. How well are we carrying out our God-given assignment in missions? Mk 16:15,20 give us the two vital aspects:

1. RECEIVING OUR ASSIGNMENT

There is no question about Who gave us this assignment. Every person who knows Christ as Lord and Saviour will not rest until the whole world knows Christ also. Let us take this assignment seriously because:

God is concerned with missions.

Apart from God and His Eternal Plan for the Ages, there is no reason for the whole mission "enterprise". God Himself is concerned for lost souls. If Christ did not assign us to go and tell the Gospel to the whole world, then missions have neither point nor purpose.

God is at work in the world.

Jesus said, "My Father worketh hitherto, and I work" (Jn 5:17). God holds all nations, all people, and all events in His Hands. He is in full control. He is "the Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end, the first and the last" (Rev 22:13). God will open doors of mission opportunity for us to reach out to the unsaved.

God calls us to act now.

As God opens doors of mission opportunity, let us respond in obedience now, and not tarry. When God opens the doors, no one can shut them. Similarly, when He closes those doors, no one can open them [Rev 3:8]. We must seize those God-given doors of opportunity that the Lord puts before us. When God calls, we need to act now.

Brethren, having received our God-given assignment, how well have we implemented it? Especially, doing missions during this COVID situation.

2. IMPLEMENTING OUR ASSIGNMENT

The Disciples "went out and preached everywhere. The Lord worked with them..." (Mk 16:20). What reasonable expectation does Jesus have that His assignment will be carried out?

This assignment requires people to carry it out.

Jesus had the Disciples. They were few but trained. They were ordinary, but God's Spirit made them extraordinary. As their number increased, it also invited persecution, but God sustained them. A host of them were faithful unto death. Today, Christ has people like you and I to carry out His assignment. He counts on us to complete the assignment. Are we in the ranks of the dependable?

This assignment requires the Presence of the Lord.

The disciples had the Master. "The Lord worked with them". Their task was Christ-given and Christ-supervised. And so it is too with us today. Our assignment, in all of its Christ-inspired involvements, is directed by our Lord and Master. Isn't this reassuring and comforting? The Lord is our partner in missions. What more can we ask for?

This assignment requires a method.

The Gospel was proclaimed by preaching, witnessing, and writing, even by living and dying in a manner that would challenge others to come to faith in the Lord Jesus. This method of proclamation is still ours to

use today. Though there are new ways of communicating the Gospel, we cannot disparage the power of the preaching of the Word of God. God's Word that goeth forth will not return to Him void but will accomplish that which it sets out to do (Isa 55:11).

This assignment

requires mobility and motivation.

The disciples leapt barriers and crossed frontiers to preach Christ. Paul is a good example of a very mobile missionary, deeply motivated by the Holy Spirit and guided by the Master, preaching

the Gospel message to the whole world. The history of Christian missions has always been the story of people going everywhere -- led and motivated by God's Spirit to preach Christ - people faithful and diligent to the task.

This assignment requires maintenance.

Any task to be done well needs dedicated and skilled personnel [both front-line and backroom] and proper equipment/tools. Thank God for those who go forth. Thank God also for those who labour fervently in prayer for the men and women who serve in the missions field. Prayer support is essential. Prayer warriors belong to the maintenance department. When His people pray, the power of God goes forth to bless the work of the missions stations. There is much groundwork for the Church to prepare and train up workers for the missions field.

This assignment requires money.

No elaboration is necessary on the need for financial support for missions work. The Apostle Paul took collections in the churches to help the work in Jerusalem. Giving toward missions is also our assignment.

Brethren, thank God for the mission stations that the Lord has given us overseas. May Galileans grow in their zeal and vigour for missions as God blesses us with new challenges and new grounds to touch lives for Jesus. From Galilee will beam forth the Great Gospel Light!
