### BE GOOD INFLUENCERS FOR GOD

Preacher David Cher, 28 March 2021

Beloved Brethren,

Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Jesus' words to us from Matt. 5:16 "Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven" reminds us to live our lives as a positive influencing factor towards others for Christ

According to the Influencer Marketing Hub website, "an influencer is someone who has the power to affect the purchasing decisions of others because of his or her authority, knowledge, position, or relationship with his or her audience, and who has a following in a distinct niche, with whom he or she actively engages. The size of the following depends on the size of his/her topic of the niche."

As such, a good Christian must indeed develop a good Christian witness and influence in 2 main aspects: relationship with God, and with others especially non-helievers

First, to witness and bear good influence for God, we must surely have a good intimate relationship with Him and know Him well. How can we witness to and be persuasive toward others for God if we cannot testify of His goodness and how real He is in our lives? It is not only the logical and rational argument that help us to draw people to God but through the reality of God in our lives that others can truly sense it. Such a living for God is not only a momentary one, but it should indeed be a lifelong journey with Him, especially when others see how we respond and deal with difficult times in

God-glorifying and God-honouring ways.

**Second**, is how we relate meaningfully with others in our lives especially nonbelievers. No matter where God places us be it in our schools, workplaces, circle of friends, and even our families, our rightful influence must be consistent for it to be effective. We would tend to admire and follow after people whose example and actions are consistent as we can trust them for who they are. C.H. Spurgeon, a wellknown preacher during his times, said "Inconsistent professors are the greatest stumbling blocks to the spread of the cause of Christ! But when their character is changed by the abounding grace of God, they become like overflowing springs, sending streams of blessing far and wide!" In doing so, our focus would be on developing strong and fruitful relationships with the people we are seeking to influence. Proverbs 13:20 "He that walketh with wise men shall be wise: but a companion of fools shall be destroyed."

As true followers of Christ, we must never neglect this principle of influence in our lives. When we are not effectively influencing others, then we would be as "salt losing its savour" (Matthew 5:13). Consequently, we become vulnerable to the influence of others

Let us, with God helping us, ensure that our lives are influential to the cause of Christ and His kingdom. May our lives, as a result, be not hidden but shining as lights for His glory (Matthew 5:16).

May God's guidance be with us!
