“CHRIST IS RISEN, HE IS RISEN INDEED!”

Pastor Simon, 4 April 2021

Brethren,
Joyous Easter Greetings in the Precious
Name of our Risen Saviour Jesus Christ!

“**CHRIST IS RISEN, HE IS RISEN INDEED!**” resonates around the world at Easter. Think about it, the most glorious Gospel News came from the least expected place -- the cemetery, where the dead lies in silence among cold tombstones, facing a hopeless end. Job of old probed, “If a man die, shall he live again?” (Job 14:14). From this grim and melancholic place of tears, sorrow, pain and separation sprung forth the most Gladsome News of all times — **CHRIST IS**

RISEN! The angel told the women at the Tomb: “**He (Christ) is not here: for, come, see the place where the Lord lay**”. Matthew 28:6. Halleluia! Jesus, our Lord and Saviour has conquered death!

The Easter message is a Divine Proclamation. The Apostles experienced Jesus’ Living Presence to the extent that they willingly died martyrs’ deaths rather than surrender their faith in Christ. The Empty Tomb testifies that Christ’s death on the Cross made atonement for our sins (Romans 4:25). “**Jesus paid it all. All to Him I owe. Sin had left a crimson stain. He washed it white as snow**” (E.M.Hall). Our Lord Jesus endured the agony of false accusations and judicial condemnation, and suffered an indescribably horrible death on the Cross to atone for the sins of mankind. The Substitutionary Death of Christ on the Cross met perfectly the requirement of a Just and Holy God who will bring every sin into judgment. Christ accomplished at Calvary the perfect redemption of our souls, sparing us from the penalty of our sin, saving us from eternal death.

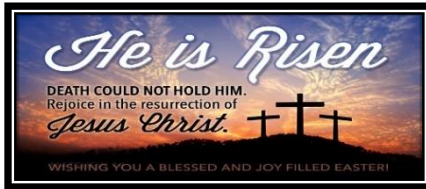
The Empty Tomb was for the Apostles, and for us, the promise of victory over death! Jesus comforted Martha when her brother Lazarus died: “I am the Resurrection, and the Life: he that believeth in Me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: And

whosoever liveth and believeth in Me shall never die. Believest thou this?” (John 11:25–26). Christ our Blessed Redeemer also declared, “**Because I live, ye shall live also**” (John 14:19). What glorious promise and hope for all who believe in Christ! Praise God that our loved ones who have “slept” in the Lord are in the Heavenly Home, in the sweet Presence of God and in the fellowship with the Heavenly saints. “Absent from the body, to be present with the Lord” 2 Corinthians 5:8. We who are alive today, if the Lord tarries, will embrace death with God’s special grace and go to our celestial home one day. Indeed, death is not a dead-

end road! The Apostle Paul proclaimed: “O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory? The sting of death is sin; and the strength of sin is the law. But thanks be to God, Which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ” 1 Corinthians 15:55-57. “**CHRIST IS RISEN!**” – Because Christ our Redeemer lives, we have defeated the power and tyranny of death.

Brethren, let us joyfully herald the blessed truth of Christ’s Resurrection. **Go and tell** it to the great and small, to the poor and rich, to the weak and powerful, to nations and communities, to families and individuals that our Living Saviour offers the Greatest Gift of eternal life to all -- If they confess with their mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in their hearts that God has raised Christ from the dead, they will be saved. “For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation” Romans 10:9-10. Brethren, it is our duty to proclaim the Glorious Gospel -- so that none needs to live under the bondage of sin and face a hopeless end in eternity. Let’s share the pertinent truth: “For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord” Romans 6:23. Blessed Easter to one and all!

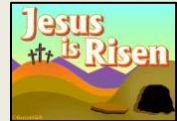

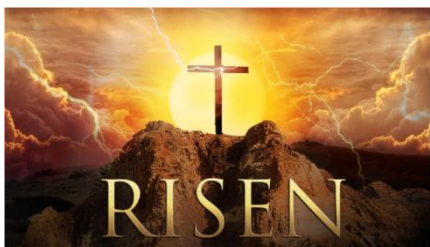



Getaway @ Galilee - Report

On Sat 27 March, Galileans prayed and prepared to welcome Pandan residents for a day of rest and relaxation.

- A total of 5 people came
- 3 were Pandan residents
- A few rounds of heavy rain may have hindered more from coming
- Small groups went to Blk 411 to invite residents, distribute dry food items to

foreign workers carrying out renovation works, and help the Mandarin congregation spread the word about their upcoming Easter Gospel Service.

We learnt that this type of event lacks appeal to the residents, and may not be what they want, even if they might need some rest and relaxation. We thank God for the learning opportunity.

We also thank God for the blessing of coming together as a family in Christ to serve our neighbours - a large turnout of 30 Galileans availed themselves to help out. As the rain kept us in church, we had the blessing of taking time to talk and listen to each other in small groups, in a relaxed atmosphere. There were also scenes of people praying for each other, and serving one another by giving each other massages and foot soaks.

We originally set out to wash others' feet, but we were reminded that Jesus had been speaking to His disciples when He told them to wash one another's feet. Thank God for the blessing and joy of serving one another in unhurried fellowship (especially after a year of COVID).

Continue to pray for the Love Our Neighbours Ministry and do join us :) We will experience God's goodness together as we continue to serve Him together.
