

HAVING GOD'S HEART IN OUR WORK

Preacher David Cher, 25 April 2021

Beloved Brethren,

Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. When we hear of the word "work", we often associate it with our jobs and the means with which to sustain our livelihood as well as our families. However, "work" can more generally refer to any form of physical or mental activity such as keeping fit through physical exercise, composing a song or poem, and even studies. No matter with which sense we understand work to be, when we lose sight of the purpose and meaning of it, we would tend to dread and drag our feet through it.

Instead, we should understand that work is not a curse in our lives, but has been given to us by God. God first gave Adam the responsibility to tend the Garden of Eden (Gen 2:15). It is only after Adam and Eve fell into sin that work became hard and difficult. But we are still to work hard with whatever the good Lord has given for us to do (Prov 14:23; 2 Thess 3:10). Everything that we are and have belongs completely to Him. We do not own anything but are merely stewards of His gifts to us. This includes our bodies, our possessions, our money, and everything else that is ours and also that we do, including our work and studies. All of these must then be used to God's glory.

We must be aware that no one even spiritual giants such as the prophet Elijah, and more current examples such as David Livingstone and Charles Spurgeon are not immune to discouragement and depression due to their heavy load of spiritual work and ministerial responsibilities. But it is only through their dependence and finding their source of strength in God that they can eventually cope with and overcome their feelings of discouragement and depression. Similarly, when our work gets hard going, we should not become discouraged. As mere human beings, we surely are vulnerable to the stresses and pressures of our work, which can wear us out. When we feel discouraged in our work, we will need to remind ourselves that God who has placed us where we are in our work, would surely give us His grace and strength that we need to fulfil and flourish in our work. Isaiah 40:30-31 gives us the contrast that when we depend on our human strength, we would grow tired and weary, but when we depend on God's strength, we would be renewed and reinvigorated to press on in our work.

Even though work is often seen as an integral part of our lives, we should not view it as the only thing that defines our lives. Besides this one area of work in our lives, there are also other areas of our lives that we need to pay attention to, such as our families, our health and vitality, and our spiritual work and service in the church. These other areas are also equally important, and thus can also be seen as parts of God's mission for our lives (Romans 12:1).

As we recognise work as God's work for us, it should be very natural and obvious to us that we need to be focused on our intimate fellowship with God. Our intimate fellowship with God would mean that we are walking in obedience and submission to God and His Word (1 John 1:5-7), as well as having His heartbeat, mission, goals and plans in our hearts.

1 Cor. 15:58 "Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord".
