Haunted By Our Past?

Beloved Brethren,

Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Talking to people who come to seek counsel, it dawned on me that many Christians are haunted by their past. In fact, they are tyrannized by it. They "freeze" whenever they are reminded of their past. One of Satan's subtle darts against believers is to keep us trapped in our painful past, so as to distract us in our walk with God, to cause us to look inward into self, and be "paralyzed" and be made ineffective by guilt and shame. How are we to respond when Satan placards our past before us?

The very first thing we must do is to apply afresh to our disturbed mind and shamed spirit, the glorious truth that God in Christ remembers our sins no more, that however scarlet our sinful past, the atoning Blood of the Lamb of God has cleansed us whiter than snow. How basic this truth – and yet how precious! Listen to the soul-stirring words of the Apostle Paul in 1 Corinthians 6:11 – "And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the Name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God."

What are we to say to people whose lives have been shamed and soiled by idolatry, immorality, adultery, homosexuality, greed, drunkenness, and additions of all kinds? We tell them the precious promise of God: "If we confess our sins, He [God] is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (1 Jn 1:9). God's forgiveness is based on the Blood of His Son shed at Calvary.

Brethren, whenever we have sinned against God, we must conscientiously confess our sin before Him, and in His infinite mercy, God will put the Blood of His Son to "wipe off"

our sin. We do not take our sin and put it under the Blood. It is the faithful and just God Who applies the Blood of Jesus Christ which cleanses us from the guilt of sin. Believers are called to "confess our sins" and to "walk in the light as He [God] is in the light" (1 Jn 1:9, 7). When we do that, we can claim the promise that God is faithful and just to forgive us of our sins. God is faithful in the sense that He has promised to forgive and He will abide by His promise. God is just to forgive because He has found a righteous basis for forgiveness in the substitutionary work of the Lord Jesus on the Cross.

And God has promised not only to forgive, He will also "cleanse us from all unrighteousness". Forgiven by God, cleansed by the Blood of the Lamb, and restored into fellowship with God, we are to carry on fellowship with God and fellow-Christians.

Brethren, when we feel hopeless and bogged by our sins, we must all the more cling tightly to the glorious assurance from God's Word – "The Blood of Jesus Christ His Son <u>cleanses</u> us" – and it continue to cleanse us – "from all our sins". "If we confess our sins, He [God] is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."

When we confess our sins, we must believe, on the authority of the Word of God, that God forgives. And if God forgives us, we must be willing to forgive ourselves. With our conscience cleansed, the past will not come back to haunt us again. And God will give us His peace to confidently stride forth to walk closely with Him.


