

NGOLENI CHURCH REPORT 2021

Greetings in our Lord's name,

It's my sincere hope that you are all doing well by God's grace. Thank you very much for your prayer and support. We all dearly appreciate.

As requested, below is a detailed church report for the first quarter of the year 2021.

The situation in Ngoleni

I would to report that, we are thankful to God in in Ngoleni, the general situation in Ngoleni is so so, because of the current global pandemic. But by the grace of the Lord, we are preserved and are coping well with the situation. We just had our national examinations for the primary eight, we had 5 candidates from the church, now we have the national examinations for the secondary level, and we have three students from the church. We thank God for these blessings and opportunities for prayer.

Church activities

Since last year, we have been gearing on for the ordination of the church deacons, so I have been conducting deaconship classes every Saturday, God willing our candidates in Ngoleni will be sitting for an exam in three weeks' time. So far, so good. We have three candidates who have been consistent, one gentleman and two ladies.

Since March 19th, the president and MOH declared 5 counties as disease infested area, of those five counties, Machakos is one of them, (*Machakos is our home* (*Ngoleni*) *county*). What this meant is that, in all the disease infested counties we can interact with come another but we can't go out of these counties meaning people from Machakos-Ngoleni cannot visit Kavingoni (Makueni county). Also, congregational worship was cancelled in all these five counties.

Therefore, I responded by arranging small home worship groups. I have three meetings every Sunday in selected homes, that's how we conduct worship every weekend. We don't have formal Sunday School now; we meet Sunday school

members during the home worship meetings. We don't know how long this will last. We are trusting the Lord.

Church members

The church members are resilient even through this period of uncertainty, most of them are in good health and have been coming for the home worship sessions. But about 20% of the church membership has been slow in transitioning to the current mode of worship, I am encouraging them to participate. I also utilize zoom and conference call sessions to reach out to a few members who can access such.

COVID-19

The country is going through the third wave of the pandemic. The situation was bad but its gradually improving. As I had mentioned, we have five counties under lock down and with public gatherings cancelled, we have a curfew in place from 8pm to 4 am. The vaccine is being rolled out depending on age basis. I have already taught the church regarding the vaccine and encouraged them to have it for their health. Pastors of whatever age have been classified as frontline workers, I have since been vaccinated already.

Praise and prayer requests

- We thank the Lord for the successful completion of the Kenya Certificate of Primary Education exams where we had five candidates. Will ask for prayer for the three candidates who are now in the process of the national secondary exams, the exam is slated to end on 23rd April 2021.
- We have a lady who has been worshipping with us for 2 years but not formally a church member since she is here as a government teacher. Well, she will be undergoing a risky **caesarian section** (surgery) procedure this week, she may need blood transfusion, we have four people who are ready to donate blood as of today (19/04/2021). Please, pray for her; she is Esther, a high school teacher.
- Do pray for the Covid situation here, the economic situation isn't good at all, people have lost jobs, others are facing salary cuts, schools have been closed except at university level where we are doing virtual study.
