# REMAINING STRONG IN GOD

Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 27 June 2021

**B**eloved Brethren,  
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. As we experience the constantly evolving COVID-19 situation in our home nation of Singapore with its comparatively good and bad infection numbers and rates, we are also reminded of the high (“mountain”) and low (“valleys”) points of our lives. As such, it is not how we can avoid difficult situations in our lives, but how we can cope with, and remain strong in our Heavenly Father.

To cope with the “mountains” and “valleys” in our lives, we need to maintain a sure and stable relationship and fellowship with our Almighty God and Heavenly Father. When we have such a stable relationship with Him, we would be like the wise man in Matt. 7:24-25, having our confidence and assurance from the faithful promises in His Word. In contrast, we would not be shaken like the foolish man in Matt. 7:26-27 during the trying and low times in our lives. Though at such low times in our lives when we may feel alone and abandoned by God, we must remind ourselves of the goodness and faithfulness and Abiding Presence of God. 2 Tim. 1:7 tells us that “For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind”.

One important aspect of a stable relationship with our Heavenly Father is having a continual dependence on Him, and not on ourselves. When we constantly depend on God, our hearts would be one of humility and not self-pride. Instead of focusing on our human successes, accomplishments, and achievements, our prayer life would be vibrant and fervent in its expressions instead of a mere “going through the motions”. Such a fervent prayer life, whether in a corporate (church) or individual sense, would be

reflective of our inner spiritual vibrancy. As Charles Spurgeon said, “If the engine room is out of action, then the whole mill will grind to a halt. We cannot expect blessing if we do not ask.”

We must also realise that our stable relationship with our Heavenly Father is based on God's sustaining grace. This means that God's grace will certainly help us to overcome the troubles in our lives (1 Cor. 10:13). The Apostle Paul also experienced this with the thorn in his flesh which he asked God three times to remove from him (2 Cor. 12:7-8). However, God did not remove this thorn from Paul's life but instead encouraged Paul that His grace, strength, and power are always with him.

When we have God's sustaining grace in our lives, we would first be able to overcome the trials and temptations that come our way (1 Cor. 10:13 “There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it”). Our confidence in God's sustaining grace will ensure that we would come out of life's challenges with our faith in God much stronger (1 Peter 1:7).

Let us commit to, even in the midst of the “mountains” and “valleys” of our lives, maintaining our sure and stable relationship with our Heavenly Father such that they reflect the bountiful grace and blessings of God in our lives (2 Cor. 12:9 “And He [God] said unto me [Paul], My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me”).
