



reetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Praise and thank God for the voting progress for our Church General Elections is going well. Encourage everyone, to participate actively in this once in three years' event.

Encouragement is what everyone in the Church needs. Yet, we don't always get it. Let's be honest. Many of us are opinionated, self-centred,

and sometimes, dealings with others with less kindness. This ought not to be! I believe that the Lord would have us practise a ministry of encouragement as we serve in the kingdom of God. In Acts 4:36,37, we are introduced to Barnabas who stepped into the Church scene, out of obscurity, doing good. The Bible's record of Barnabas' life and ministry shows him as one who had the heart to do good to all those with whom he came into contact. Let's see how he earned the title "son of consolation." The word "consolation" comes from the same word that is translated as "Comforter", and which refers to the Holy Spirit. It is someone who comes alongside another person to offer help and encouragement. Barnabas was the only one, among the Disciples of Christ, who had earned this reputation.

In Acts 9:26-27, we learnt of the glorious conversion of Saul of Tarsus. After Saul was converted, he tried to unite himself with the other Disciples who were in Jerusalem, but out of fear and prejudice about his past, they did not allow him into their group. However, Barnabas came to Saul's side and told the others about Saul's amazing conversion. He stood up for Saul when he desperately needed a friend, help and fellowship in the Lord's work. There is still a

need for this kind of ministry today! Let us take the effort and time to reach out and help those

around us who are feeling lonely, rejected or in dire need. We should do our best to reach out and do what we can for we are members of the same household of faith. Our selfless care will strengthen the unity and inspire one another in the Body of Christ. Let us actively practise the ministry encouragement. You can be a friend

and a blessing to someone every day.

In Acts 15:36-40; Paul, Barnabas and John Mark were together on a missionary journey. For some reason, John Mark left them and returned to Jerusalem (Acts 13:13). When Paul and Barnabas were ready to go on missions again, Barnabas wanted to take John Mark along to give him a second chance. But Paul objected! Hence, Barnabas parted company. Paul took Silas with him, while Barnabas took John Mark. From this point, there was no further mention of Barnabas in the Bible. However, his ministry to John Mark had a far-reaching impact on the life of John Mark! Because Barnabas gave this discouraged and defeated young man a second chance. John Mark's life as a servant of God was salvaged. Before Paul died in Rome, he requested to see John Mark (2 Tim. 4:11). Even more important is that God used Mark to pen the Gospel of Mark which gives us an exciting account of the life and ministry of the Lord Jesus Christ.

Brethren, even as we ask the Lord to use us, let us also ask Him to develop the skills within us to do this indispensable ministry of encouragement, even in Galilee! God Bless!
