## Galilee Mandarin Worship Service 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary

On this day, we are celebrating Mandarin Worship Service's 30th anniversary! It is no small thing for the Mandarin congregation to faithfully worship God for the past 30 years.

Mandarin Worship Service started from humble beginnings - it is amazing to see how it has grown from a small sapling into a large tree. Thank God for our early founding pastor, Rev Philip Heng. Through him, the Mandarin Worship Service was inaugurated with Moses Tan, as the first preacher in July 1991. Subsequently, Rev Ong Hock Khee took charge after he was ordained on Oct. 12, 1997. In January 2012, Rev Ong requested to step down as Pastor of Mandarin Worship Service. Pastor Heng took charge again and members were praying for a Mandarin pastor.

I came in 2013 when Pastor Heng went for his sabbatical year leave. On July 15, 2014, I became the full-time pastor of Mandarin Worship Service and has served two terms as her pastor. We saw God using the Mandarin Worship Service to serve among the Mandarin-speaking community and the congregation grew from a handful of 30 members to over 60 people. Praise the Lord!

We went through the 2020 Covid-19 crisis and our attendance declined to 30 people which was our original size. But we are assured that the church is not an organization, but more an organism. Thus, it will grow again, as it is "not by might, not by power, but by my spirit, saith the Lord of hosts" (Zech. 4:6).

May this 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Mandarin Worship Service reminds us to continue its good work and blessed ministry. May God continue to lead and guide the Mandarin congregation by the power of the Lord Jesus Christ. May God's Word encourage us to "Not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up" (Gal. 6:9). Once again, we give thanks for the Mandarin Worship Service's 30th anniversary and may we all continue to worship our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ for many more years to come.

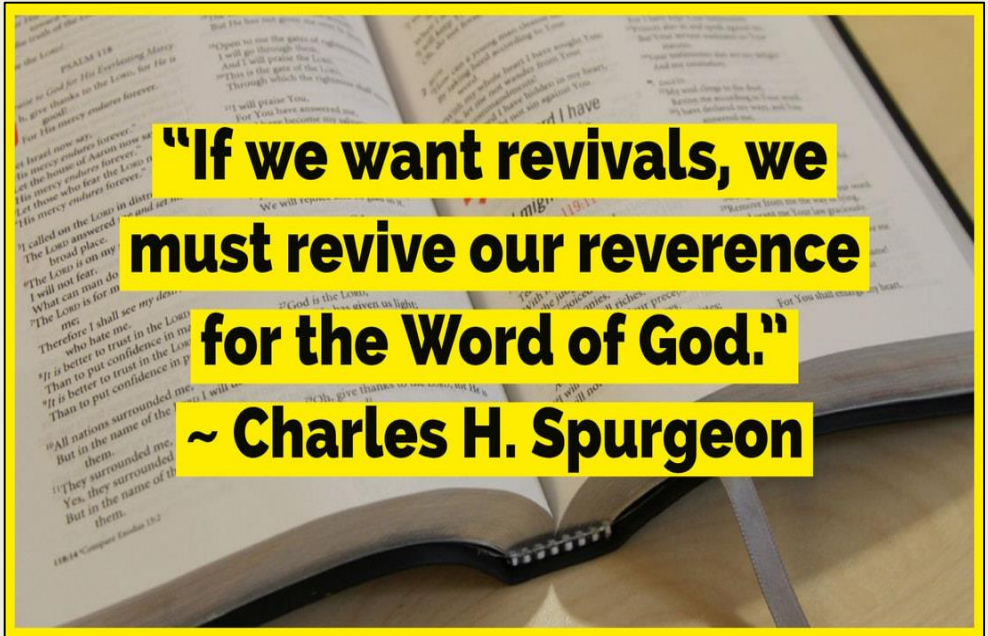

# My Next Phase Of Ministry

I am thankful to all of you for your love and concern for me. Some of you have enquired why I did not stand for the church election. Let me begin by saying that the decision not to stand for election was made after much prayer, consideration and discussion with my family.

I want to praise God for sustaining me in my ministry at Galilee for the past more than three decades. The Lord has richly blessed me and my family through Galilee and the Galileans.

My stepping down does not mean I am quitting from my calling to teach and preach the Word of God. I remember vividly in 1986 the Lord called me to full-time theological study. I hesitated and struggled with the Lord for three weeks before I yielded to His calling.

Allow me now to share with you the following reasons for not standing for election:

1) As you may all know, I have been undergoing dialysis for my kidneys. This takes up 4 hours per day, 3 times a week of my time. While my health in general has improved, my medical situation is for lifetime. In some ways, this means that physically I am also limited in the things I would like to do in the ministry.

2) My wife and I are now living by ourselves in our evening years. The Bible is clear, the years of our life are seventy, or even by strength, eighty. It is therefore my intention to spend more time with my wife, my children and grandchildren as long as God permits.

3) With the election of new Session members soon approaching, from practical perspective, this allows me to transit smoothly out of Session – having completed my previous term of office. This also gives the BOE time to pray and plan for the next term with full knowledge of my decision.

At this point, I am committing the future to the Lord. The Lord knows best where to use me in my next phase of ministry. Please pray for me and my wife.
