

The Church Family

Pastor Simon N, Lord's Day, 29 August, 2021

Rethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. We are a Church family. In our natural family, we are all not the same. Not everyone is good at everything. We are unique in our ways; precious in our family settings. We work and support each other. We rejoice and weep together. I liken the Church in the same fashion. Besides our natural family, we also belong to a spiritual family.

You may ask, "Who Is My Family"?

Jesus asked the same question, didn't He? While talking to the people, His mother and His brethren came desiring to speak with Him. On that occasion, He answered His question saying, "For whosoever shall do the Will of My Father which is in Heaven, the same is My brother, and sister, and mother" (Mt 12:46-50). Our Lord was not denying His responsibility to His earthly family. Jesus' emphasis was that spiritual relationship was as binding as physical ones, paving the way for a new community of believers, our spiritual family.

The Scripture expands our family tree, doesn't it? Heb 2:11 tells us: "For both He that sanctifieth and they who are sanctified are all of one: for which cause He is not ashamed to call them brethren". Jesus and the people He makes holy all belong to the same family. That is why He was not ashamed to call them His brothers and sisters. Isn't that neat?

- 1. Unvaccinated Children below 12 can participate in the service with a cap of no more than 20%
- Those exempted from vaccination due to medical ground must produce a COVID-19 negative test report/certificate from a MOH approved clinic that is valid on the day of attending the worship service. Or they have a PET exemption notice.
- 3. Self-test kits result are NOT accepted.
- 4. NO congregational singing allowed
- 5. NO intermingling
