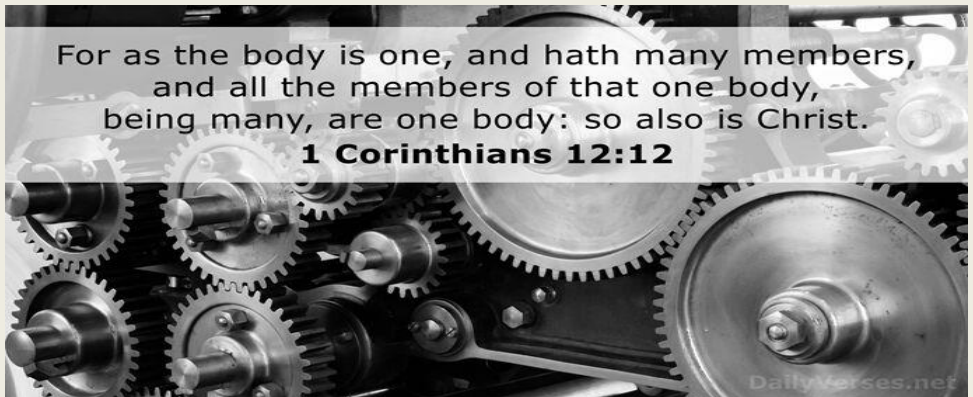

The Church Family

Pastor Simon N, Lord's Day, 29 August, 2021

Brethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. We are a Church family. In our natural family, we are all not the same. Not everyone is good at everything. We are unique in our ways; precious in our family settings. We work and support each other. We rejoice and weep together. I liken the Church in the same fashion. Besides our natural family, we also belong to a spiritual family.

You may ask, ***“Who Is My Family?”***

Jesus asked the same question, didn't He? While talking to the people, His mother and His brethren came desiring to speak with Him. On that occasion, He answered His question saying, “For whosoever shall do the Will of My Father which is in Heaven, the same is My brother, and sister, and mother” (Mt 12:46-50). Our Lord was not denying His responsibility to His earthly family. Jesus' emphasis was that spiritual relationship was as binding as physical ones, paving the way for a new community of believers, our spiritual family.

The Scripture expands our family tree, doesn't it? Heb 2:11 tells us: “For both He that sanctifieth and they who are sanctified are all of one: for which cause He is not ashamed to call them brethren”. Jesus and the people He makes holy all belong to the same family. That is why He was not ashamed to call them His brothers and sisters. Isn't that neat?

How precious is the family of God! In 1 Cor 12:18, we learn that God has placed each one of us in the body of Christ, as He desired. No one is redundant, or inferior, but precious in His sight (Ps 17:8). Do you believe that God wants the Church family preserved and our unity kept? Yes, God has established diversity and prescribed unity in the same breath (1 Cor 12:20) and we will faithfully look after it.

Families Care For Each Other

The Bible teaches: “Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ” (Gal 6:2). We should help each other bear the heavy burdens of life. TRANSITING OUT OF PHASE TWO (HEIGHTEN ALERT)

With the new advisory issued by MCCY to Religious Organisations on 11 August 2021, Galilee BP Church will implement the following from 5 September 2021:

As we move into the vaccinated worshippers only worship service, please note the following:

1. Unvaccinated Children below 12 can participate in the service with a cap of no more than 20%.
2. Those exempted from vaccination due to medical ground must produce a COVID-19 negative test report/certificate from a MOH approved clinic that is valid on the day of attending the worship service. Or they have a PET exemption notice.
3. Self-test kits result are NOT accepted.
4. NO congregational singing allowed
5. NO intermingling
6. All attendees must be masked throughout the worship service
7. Those who are unwell or sick are encouraged not to attend Worship Service in Church but to stay at home for online Service.
