

## "Let us go to the House of the LORD" Ps 122:1

Pastor Simon N, Lord's Day, 5 September, 2021

hy Go To Church? Brethren, greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ! Not too long ago a brother-in-Christ asked me "Why should I go to church? Isn't God everywhere?" He further quipped: "In our sophisticated IT age, we have at our finger-tips.... a galore of tele-evangelists, YouTube preachers, a myriad of freely available sermons on the internet, not to mention loads of Christian devotional materials, neatly packaged to meet the spiritual needs of people of all ages. With all these facilities and resources so conveniently available at the click of a button on our PC or mobile phone, why do we need to wake up early on Sunday, go through the hassle of getting the family ready and on time, to make our way to Church at all?

Though, this brother's reasoning may sound logical and even practical... BUT the people of God must never neglect to gather together on the Lord's Day to worship our God regularly. How blessed it is when the Church family meets in God's House to worship God and grow "in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ" (2 Pet 3:18). After a season of worshipping online, let us rekindle the desire to worship God in the Church.

Slightly over a year, we have become accustomed to following online worship services. The Early Church experienced poor attendance for worship service in the church because of persecution and struggles in life. The Apostle Paul cautions Christians not to forsake "the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the Day approaching" (Heb 10:25). Allow me to draw your focus on just two but very vital reasons why we should go to church always.

THE BLESSINGS IN WORSHIP! We go to church to exalt God, our Maker, in worship. Worship is the right and proper response of the creation to the Creator. In Rev 4:10-11, "The four and twenty elders fall down before Him that sat on the Throne, and worship Him that liveth forever and ever, and cast their crowns before the Throne, saying, Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and

power: for Thou hast created all things, and for Thy pleasure, they are and were created". Despite our busy lives and technological conveniences, we need to make time for God and the things of God. When we are in His presence, having laid aside all the problems and worries of the week to only focus on God and commune with Him, we begin to enjoy God working in us during the worship, empowering us through His Word and hymns to persevere life challenges, receiving the much-needed grace to live a life pleasing to Him. God delights to see His people in unison singing praises to Him and listening to His Word. At pastoral prayer, our bond in Christ and with one another increases as we pray for one another. Participating in Holy Communion further deepens the relationship with Christ. In the Lord's sanctuary, basking in the sweet Presence of our Lord, we experience joy and peace as He lovingly and tenderly calms our anxieties, refreshes our spirit and strenathening our faith in Him for vet another week.

THE BLESSINGS IN FELLOWSHIP! An integral characteristic of the Church is our bond not only with Christ as the Head (Eph 1:22-23) but also with one another (1 Cor 12:12-14). "One Lord, one faith, one baptism" (Eph 4:5). The "Body" of Christ is intimately connected, supporting one another (1 Cor 12:20-26). We enjoy the blessed fellowship seeking to build one another up in the Lord. When one falters in his walk with God, the Church family rallies around to encourage him to keep trusting the Lord. When one falls, the Church family is there to support him. God loves us unconditionally, and we reflect the same love to fellow believers and worshippers (1 John 4:7). Together, as a church family, we grow in the Lord. Can the Church family, the Lord's people, ever forsake the coming together in the Lord's House? No!

Brethren, let us make it our top priority to meet in God's House regularly for worship, fellowship and learn of God's Word so that we may together grow in our faith, be equipped to carry out the Great Commission, considering always to spur each other unto love and to good works" (Heb 10:24).
