WE ARE BLESSED TO WORK

Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 12 September 2021

Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Thank God for granting me the opportunity to go for further theological training and enabling me to push through till my last year of studies at Singapore Bible College. It is indeed with His guidance and enabling me that I am able to cope with my theological studies in addition to my church and family commitments.

When the word “work” is mentioned, a mental image of something that we have to do comes to our minds. As such, the attitudes of drudgery and dread can come into our work life. This happens when we lose sight of the purpose and meaning of our work, and not see it as an important part of God’s mission for us.

We should correctly understand that work is not a curse in our lives, but has been given us by God Himself. This is seen when God first gave Adam the responsibility to tend the Garden of Eden (Gen 2:15). It is only after Adam and Eve fell into sin that work became hard and with difficulties. Knowing this, we are still to work wholeheartedly with whatever the good Lord has given for us to do (Prov 14:23; 2 Thess 3:10). This is because the heart is the centre of our lives, and thus control everything in our lives (Prov 4:23).

When our work gets hard going, what are we to do? Would discouragement and setbacks affect our heart toward our work? As mere human beings, we are surely vulnerable to the stresses and pressures of our work which have the capacity to wear us out. When we feel discouraged in our work, we need to

remind ourselves that God who has placed us where we are in our work, would surely give us His grace and strength that we need to fulfil and flourish in our work. Isaiah 40:30-31 gives us the contrast that when we depend on our own human strength, we would grow tired and weary, but when we depend on God’s strength, we would be renewed and re-invigorated to press on in our work.

Even spiritual giants such as the prophet Elijah, and other examples such as David Livingstone and Charles Spurgeon have gone through difficult seasons and struggles with discouragement and depression in their lives. No human being is immune to discouragement and depression. It is important for us to know that Elijah, David Livingstone, and Charles Spurgeon did not permanently remain in their state of being discouraged and depressed, but by God’s grace, were reminded to turn back to God and His Presence in their lives.

Work, as we understand it, should also not be equated as the only thing that defines our lives. We need to constantly remind ourselves that besides work, there are also other areas of our lives that we need to pay attention to, such as our families, our personal health and vitality, and our spiritual work and service in the church. These other areas are also equally important, and thus can also be seen as parts of God’s mission for our lives (Romans 12:1).

Let us keep our focus on and not neglect our intimacy and walk with God, letting His grace and strength to help us fulfil and flourish in our work (1 Cor 15:58). Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye steadfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord.
