

UNDER THE SHADOW OF THE ALMIGHTY

Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 26 September 2021

Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Have you ever been stressed and pressured during your times of struggle? Who or what do you turn to for escape or deliverance during such times?

We are given the sure advice from Psalm 91:1 to “dwell in the secret place of the Most High and thus abide under the shadow of the Almighty”. When we hear of the word “shadow”, our minds would jump to the familiar verse from Psalm 23:4a “Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death”, and we can feel the all-familiar human attitudes of fear and trepidation. However, in this case, this shadow of the Almighty and the related of the secret place of the Most High is leading us to the important concept of the shelter, comfort, and safety of a huge overhanging tree from the summer heat. As a result, we would not be constantly burdened and weighed down by our various fears and concerns, but instead, find our much-needed rest in our Almighty God.

This is what Corrie Ten Boom truly experienced in and through her life. Corrie Ten Boom was a simple and ordinary woman living with her older sister and father in the Netherlands when she was arrested by the Nazis. Convicted for being the leader of an underground ring that hid Jews in their home during the Holocaust, she was imprisoned and sent to a concentration camp along with her sister, Betsie. By God's grace, Corrie survived her time at the concentration camp and made an incredible impact for the sake of the gospel. While Corrie physically and emotionally faced battle after battle during World War II, her spirit was not shaken because the Lord was her dwelling place.

Knowing that God is offering the shadow of His shelter, comfort, and safety, all that we need to do is to draw near to Him and His Presence. Drawing near to God and His Presence should be a continual and daily practice in our lives. Charles Spurgeon says, “Every child of God looks towards the inner sanctuary and the mercy seat, yet all do not dwell in the most holy place; they run to it at times, and enjoy occasional approaches, but they do not habitually reside in the mysterious presence”. We are thus to spend our regular time dwelling in God's Word and praying to Him so that our minds and hearts are not cluttered and distracted from God and matters of His Kingdom.

Not only do we have the shelter, comfort, and safety from God, we also have His protection as what is said in Psalm 91:2 “I will say of the Lord, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust”. When we have complete trust and confidence in God, it means that we are prepared to follow Him and His leading for our lives, and this includes possibly stepping out of our comfort zone. We are reminded of this same divine leading that enabled Joshua to have the courage and not fear to lead the entire nation of Israel to conquer the various “giants” in the Promised Land of Canaan (Joshua 1:9). This is especially so when the relatively young Joshua had to take over the role of the recently departed Moses.

Instead of placing our hope in earthly and transitory things such as our worldly plans, goals, and ambitions, let us seek peace and security in God's Shadow and Protection (Phil. 4:7). We would then experience His spiritual blessings and sustenance in our lives (Jeremiah 17:7-8).
