

"IN TIMES LIKE THESE... SEEK GOD!"

Pastor Simon N, Lord's Day, 3 October 2021

Brethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. We living in a time, where it has become indispensable for believers to seek God persistently, consistently, and whole-heartedly. The Psalmist exhorts, "Let the heart of them rejoice that seek the Lord. Seek the Lord, and His strength: seek His face evermore" (Ps 105:3, 4).

When the word "**seek**" is coupled with God and His promises, it is indeed a magnificent word. Our Lord Jesus Christ has promised, "**Seek** and ye shall find!" (Mt 7:7). Never be ashamed to be called a "seeker" after God's heart. It is humbling to admit being a seeker. It shows a lack and a need. By definition, a seeker does not have something he wants or needs. Everybody is seeking something all the time. But the Christian is to seek the Lord at all times and in all that he does. The Bible tells us: "Blessed [are] they that... **seek** Him [the Lord] with the whole heart" (Ps 119:2). "Let all those that **seek** Thee rejoice and be glad in Thee" (Ps 40:16). Have you not experienced a sense of growing **JOY** as you seek the Lord in your daily walk with Him? The Magi who sought the Promised Messiah was filled with joy when they found Baby Jesus in the manger. Note, brethren, that the Magi's journey was long, physically strenuous and hazardous, but they persevered and were rewarded because they desired to seek after God.

WE MUST SEEK THE LORD

It is certainly God's Will for man to seek after Him! God's Word given through His prophets of old directs man to seek Him. "**Seek** ye the LORD while He may be found; call ye upon Him while He is near" (Isaiah 55:6); "Sow to yourselves in righteousness, reap in mercy; break up your fallow ground: for it is time to seek

the LORD, till He come and rain righteousness upon you" (Hosea 10:12). And through His Son, our Lord Jesus Christ: "**Seek** ye first the Kingdom of God, and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added unto you" (Mt 6:33).

Does man seek after God on his own? No, not one. "The LORD looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were any that did understand, [and] seek God. They are all gone aside, they are [all] together become filthy: [there is] none that doeth good, no, not one" (Ps 14:2-3). "There is none that seeketh after God" (Rom 3:11). God, in His mercy, sought us first! The Holy Spirit puts a conviction and needs in our hearts to seek God, to live for Him on earth and with Him eternally in Heaven! Praise be to God! And by God's grace, our hearts respond in obedience, unto repentance and reconciliation with our Maker.

We can and we will find God if we seek Him wholeheartedly (Jere 29:13). In our Quiet Time with the Lord, we seek Him in prayer and the study of His Word, He will be found. And God will direct our lives, heal all our hurts and pains, and fill us with His peace and joy. Every believer should seek God and His Word, to seek His favour, to conform to His image, to serve Him and to enjoy His fellowship.

The Christian life is not a "bed of roses". There are "thorns" to contend with. We need the grace, strength and power of God to see us through. "**Seek**", "**seek**", "**seek**" [after] God – this word appears three times in two short verses (Ps 105:3,4). To seek God's face is to desire His presence, His good pleasure, and His favour. Let us seek the Lord every day and every moment of our lives and for "evermore." God bless!
