FINDING OUR HOPE IN GOD

eloved Brethren,

Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. When we experience personal trials, hardships and difficulties in our lives, we can be tempted to focus our attention on them. When we do so, our personal desires and hopes can be shattered and unfulfilled, leaving us in an emotional state of disappointment and hopelessness. How then can we not remain languishing in them, but be able to come out from such disappointment and hopelessness?

We must first realise that we as Christians are not immune to the trials, hardships and difficulties that come into our lives (1 Peter 4:12 "Beloved, think it not strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened unto you"). We are indeed living in a fallen world with all its corrupting consequences in the natural world such as natural disasters, diseases, viruses and accidents, and also conflicts and disruptions in personal relationships. Even in such negative life situations, it remains an absolute fact that nothing can indeed separate us from the overwhelming love of God (Romans 8:35-39).

We should also not continue to place our hope and expectation on such earthly desires and hopes that can be transient and temporal. Instead, we should know that God is the Only Person Who would never leave us nor forsake us to struggle on our own. When we have the Presence of God in our lives, we would have the courage and confidence from God to face our personal struggles (Deut. 31:6 "Be strong and of a good courage, fear not, nor be afraid of them: for the Lord thy God, He it is that doth go with thee; He will not fail thee, nor forsake thee").

Joni Eareckson Tada met with a tragic diving accident when she was 17. As a result, she became a quadriplegic, confined to a wheelchair, and unable to use her hands. Even after two years of rehabilitation, she never regained the use of her legs or hands. Thus, for many years, she also struggled with despair to the point of depression, with the main questions and doubts of why God allowed her to meet with that tragic accident and what He wanted to accomplish in her life through that. It is only through her intense time with God and His Word that she eventually found her peace and and spiritual strength.

It is surely God and not our strengths and abilities that sustains us through such hard times (Lam. 3:22-25 "It is of the Lord's mercies that we are not consumed, because His compassions fail not. They are new every morning: great is Thy faithfulness. The Lord is my portion, saith my soul; therefore will I hope in Him. The Lord is good unto them that wait for Him, to the soul that seeketh Him").

Let our hope in Christ enables us to live a full and victorious life for God's glory and honour (John 10:10; Romans 8:37).
