#### Can I Be A Guarantor?

Pastor Simon N., Lord's Day, 14 November 2021

Prethren, Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ! Praise and thank God for sustaining us for the last 10 months. In the light of COVID-19, economies everywhere and in most sectors are sluggish. There is concern, anxiety over business survival, job security and erosion of investments. There is no escape for us. However, God is our refuge and strength (Ps 46:1). In a time like this, let's take note of God's financial counsel.

"My son, if thou be **surety** for thy friend, if thou hast stricken thy hand with a stranger, Thou art snared with the words of thy mouth, thou art taken with the words of thy mouth" (Prov 6:1,2) "A man void of understanding striketh hands, and becometh **surety** in the presence of his friend" (Prov 17:18).

In our genuine quest to help others, we must not overlook the counsel from God's Word. The Biblical teaching regarding "Standing Surety", or on being a guarantor for someone else's financial commitments. A guarantor is a "person who makes a contract to see performed what another has undertaken". He pledges to be responsible for another person's obligations. It is a legal commitment - to be taken seriously! We have heard sad stories about people who got themselves into financial trouble because they signed on the dotted line as guarantors for relatives, friends or colleagues who defaulted in payment or worse. absconded. These kind souls were left "holding the baby", so to speak. Their intention to help was noble and kind but sadly, had also gotten them into "hot soup". Brethren, it is right and good to help but we must be very careful how far to go. Unwise and hasty commitment to stand surety for someone who turns out to be untrustworthy has serious consequences. May God help us to be good stewards of all that He has entrusted to us.

Pledging to stand surety for another person has brought kind souls into financial difficulty when they had to pay up due to default. And when they cannot meet the payments, they will answer to the law. God's Word warns us against being impetuous and unwisely getting entangled in foolish business deals. When

There is this little hero in us, especially so in the men. The desire to be thought well of by others, or considered capable financially, has led many a man to offer security - even to those who are considered as financial risks. When a person comes sobbing for help at our doorstep [sometimes they even praise our financial standing and credibility], it touches that soft spot in us. After all, there is no monetary transaction needed at that point in time. It merely requires us to just pick up the pen and sign along the dotted lines. An action simple enough, but remember that our signature carries our pledge to see performed what another has undertaken. It is an undertaking to be responsible for someone else's obligation. Surely we can trust our good buddy not to let us down. Yes, we should try to help - where we can. But we need to know how far we can go and be prepared for the consequences. People may take advantage of our kindness. Sometimes, our buddy might not have the intention to play us out, but much that he wants to, he has no means to fulfill his undertaking. And we will have to take over.

Brethren, we cannot be hasty to stand surety. It is a decision that requires much prayer and consideration because we will be held accountable should there be a default in payment. We must seek God's guidance and wisdom before we act. It is good to seek the counsel of someone close to us. If married, we need to discuss it with our spouse. If single, let us seek the wisdom of our parents. After all, if we get into financial trouble as a result of standing surety, it would inevitably affect our family members and their welfare. We could consult our Church leaders. But no one is infallible! Even the wisest, the godliest and the most experienced are given to blunders and errors of judgment. It is good to have someone pray and think along with you. Please do not pledge to stand surety secretly on your own.

Brethren, may God help us not to get into nasty financial entanglements because of our hasty, impulsive actions, or be taken in by the sweet promises of good friends who take advantage of our kindness. Let us ask God for wisdom to be good stewards of all that He has blessed us with. Let us help wherever we can but know the limits to go. Have a blessed week ahead!
