BEING THE SALT AND LIGHT OF THE WORLD

Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 14 November 2021

Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.
Matt. 5:13-16 tells us that we are to be the salt and light of the world. In what manner can we be the salt and light of the world?

First, due to the lack of the modern technology of refrigeration during the time of the 1st century Ancient Near East, salt was used in the preservation of meat which would otherwise spoil and rot easily. Similarly, we as Christians are to be the "preservatives" standing tall amid the moral decay and decadence, and evil influences that are present in society. The good spiritual strength and stability that we have would enable us to be God's instruments of righteousness (Rom. 6:13) to effectively live out and proclaim the Gospel message to others.

Second, salt is also used, same as our present usage, to enhance the flavour of our food. Similarly, we as believers are to "enhance" the flavour or way of life in this fallen world in a positive manner (2 Cor. 2:15 "For we are unto God a sweet savour of Christ, in them that are saved, and in them that perish"). As such, we are to do good to others even when they render evil to us in situations of strife, sorrow and hatred (Luke 6:35). In the process, our human heart and will would be transformed to be more and more like God's rather than conformed or shaped according to the world (Romans 12;1-2).

Being the light of the world means that we should always be living and reflecting the world of the continuous Presence of Christ in our lives (Phil. 2:15). Our lives would thus be living out the Truth of God's Word, as well as the active carrying out of good

works that are meant to bring glory to our Heavenly Father from the watching world (Matt 5:16). No person should expect to live a life of mere personal holiness without intentionally seeking one that also touches and influences the lives of people around him or her. However, such impactful living is not always smooth with its risks and challenges. We can see such examples from the Beatitudes (Matt. 5:3-12) such as our attempts in showing mercy, making peace, or prioritizing justice that can result in you putting your advancement and ambitions on the line.

However, this same passage in Matt. 5 also mention that both salt and light can lose the purpose that they were created for, in being contaminated and respectively hidden When (verses 13b-15). salt becomes contaminated, it becomes useless and even poisonous. When light is hidden, it is as if it is not lighted up at all, and is also allowing the surrounding darkness to overwhelm it. Our Christian walk can indeed be distracted and diluted by the attractions and things of the world if we are not careful and conscious of them (cf. 1John 2:15-17 - the lust of the flesh (what makes us feel good), and the lust of the eyes (what looks good to us), and the pride of life (what gives us the feeling of significance and achievement)). When we get into such situations, we need to repent of our worldliness and go back to God and His purposes for us.

Luke 14:34-35, a similar passage that also has this metaphorical reference of salt, reminds us that we need to daily take up the cross and have a wholehearted commitment to follow Christ (Luke 14:25-33) to achieve and maintain our saltiness (and also brightness) in this world.


