DOING GOD'S WORK COURAGEOUSLY

Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 28 November 2021

Beloved Brethren, Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

Joshua was given the huge responsibility of taking over the position of Moses in leading the people of Israel into the Promised Land. Not only did Joshua know that the people of Israel was difficult, murmuring (Ex. stiff-necked 16:2: Num. 14:2)and (spiritually stubborn) people (Ex. 32:9), but there was also peoples or nations that they had to conquer to possess the Promised Land. It was in the midst of such challenges and uncertainties that God gave His instruction to have courage and not be overcome or overwhelmed by feelings of fear (Deut. 31:6: Joshua 1:9).

We, who face the uncertain environment of the ongoing COVID-19 situation as well as not knowing what is in store for us in the coming next year, can also be overwhelmed by such similar feelings of fear and lose courage. How can we then be courageous and not fearful in pressing on with the Work that God has given for us to do?

Firstly, we need to know that God is everpresent with us as we endeavour to do His Work (Matt. 28:18-20; Acts 1:8). As God's Presence was with the Israelites in the pillar of cloud by day and the pillar of fire by night (Ex. 13:21-22), we are reminded of God's faithfulness that He will not leave us nor forsake us (Deut. 31:6; Joshua 1:5; Heb. 13:5). It is not only by our human power, knowledge and strategies but also the divine enablement and empowerment of the Holy Spirit that we can do God's Work (Zech. 4:6). This is especially needful when we encounter challenges and hardships that can cause us to lose the vision and mission of the Work that we have started with

Secondly, we need to keep the big picture of the vision and mission of God's Work. always in front of us. Our efforts should not be buck-shots that are sprayed aimlessly in every possible direction. Instead, they should be bullets targeted at achieving the vision and mission. This is especially needful when we are embarking on a new and exciting vision and mission, but yet having some sense of uncertainty at every corner and turn. Joshua, in conquering the Promised Land, was also engaged in something unique and in which he had no previous practical experiences in conquering strong and fortified cities. Thus, courage is lived out even in the environment or situations of fear, and that we need to press forward with courage and take risks in doing so.

Lastly, let us step forward not only as mere individuals but as **a corporate Body of Christ unitedly pressing forward as one doing the Work of God together** (Eph. 4:4-6). Each of us has been given certain spiritual gifts for us to exercise and put to good use for the edification and growth of the church (Eph. 4:7-16). In addition, when we walk and serve one another unitedly, we would be able to encourage one another (Heb. 10:24-25) and to keep one another from falling into sin and discouragement (Eccl. 4:9-12).

Let us be reminded to always keep our eyes and minds focused on and moving forward regarding the priority and importance of doing God's Work. Phil. 3:13-14 "Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before, I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus."
