A RENEWED AND REVIVED PEOPLE

Galilee Church Bulletin, Lord's Day, 12 December 2021

B eloved Brethren, Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

As we approach the end of the challenging year of 2021 and look forward to the next year

of 2022, amidst uncertainties in the world, let us focus our attention on God, His faithful Work, and His enduring Word in our lives. This was what the people during Nehemiah's time did in the 5th century B.C. when they were engaged in the rebuilding project of the walls around Jerusalem.

True renewal and revival in our

relationship with God can only be achieved through **our attitude towards the Word of God**. Though we read the triggering of the people's hearts toward God through the rebuilding of Jerusalem's walls, it must be made clear that the true source and foundation is indeed their renewed focus, desire, and passion for God's Word. As the Puritan Thomas Watson said, "Leave not off reading the Bible till you find your hearts warmed. Let it not only inform you but inflame you."

First, we need to have **our hearts always filled with the focus and interest in God's Word**. In Nehemiah 8, we read in verses one to eight of the people's intentional focus and interest in God's Word. They not only requested for a large-scale public reading of the Scriptures (v. 1) but also remained standing for the entire duration of at least 6 hours to listen attentively to it (v. 5-7). Does each of us have this same intense hunger and desire for the Word of God in our lives that we spend our daily time in it? Second, we need to not view the reading and meditating on God's Word as merely an academic and intellectual exercise, but one that should fill our hearts with the appropriate emotional responses of repentance and joy. As the people during

Nehemiah's time heard the reading of God's Word, they realised their failures and shortcomings which brought them into Babylonian Captivity. As a result, they wept tears of repentance (v. 9). But genuine repentance would not remain stuck in such a state, but would also progress to that of great thanksgiving and joy toward God's constant care and provision for them (v. 10-12). Are we

emotionally touched and charged by our daily reading and meditating on God's Word?

Finally, in addition to having an intentional focus and an emotionally-charged response to God's Word, we are to have a full and clear commitment to obey it. In Nehemiah 8, we read of the thousand years since the days of Joshua that the people neglected to properly commemorate the Feast of the Tabernacles (v. 17). During this long period of a thousand years, they did not observe it and thus lost their proper spiritual understanding and significance. Despite that they were still willing to obey God's direction in carrying it out. Have we ever faced situations in our lives when God's direction and guidance seem puzzling and senseless to our human rational thinking? Even in such situations, let us remain fully committed and dependent on God and obev His word nonetheless.

Let us determine to put God's Word as the central focus of our personal lives and in our lives in the church.
