

GOD'S FAITHFUL WORKERS

Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 26 December 2021

Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

Though we faced hardships, difficulties, and setbacks, we persevered and pressed on despite them throughout this whole year. Let us keep this important fact in our minds and hearts as we move forward to the next fast upcoming year of 2022.

Let us focus our attention on God, His faithfulness in our work and service for Him, and His sustaining grace in our lives. This was what truly enabled Timothy as a young and upcoming church leader to overcome his personal feelings of inadequacy, especially amid the challenging spiritual challenges.

When the Apostle Paul wrote 2 Timothy to his spiritual son and disciple Timothy, he was in prison in Rome for his faith in Christ (2 Tim. 1:8). Without his mentor Paul at his side, young Timothy would have physically and spiritually lonely and hopeless. Thus, despite his physical and spiritual hardships, Paul acted on his love and concern for Timothy in writing this intense letter of advice and encouragement in 2 Timothy. In encouraging Timothy, Paul would also be sparking the heart of encouragement within himself and, at the same time, preventing himself from slipping into the pits of despair and despondency.

First, we are to encourage one another to continue to work and serve our LORD. It is a fact that even spiritual giants such as the Apostle Paul and the prophet Elijah also needed times of encouragement and strengthening at times in their lives. During Paul's time in prison in Rome, God specifically sent Onesiphorus to search out and look for Paul to refresh [re-energise] him

(2 Tim. 1:16-17). When Elijah was worn out and depressed to the point of death (1 Kings 19:4), God had to physically refreshed him (1 Kings 19:6-8), spiritually refreshed him in the knowledge of His unceasing Presence (1 Kings 19:11-13), and to remove his feelings of loneliness and hopelessness in his service (1 Kings 19:14-18). Let our encouragement toward one another not be sporadic but in a never-stopping and continuous manner.

Second, each of us needs to have the three important attitudes that the soldier, the athlete, and the farmer are displaying for us in 2 Tim. 2:3-6: the focused and longsuffering dedication of the soldier, the full obedience and commitment of the athlete, and the hard and diligent work of the farmer puts in. Though we have the faithfulness and sustaining grace of God, we still need to put our energies, effort, and attention into doing and accomplishing the work and service that God Himself has given for us to do for Him.

Three, we are to not only focus on our faithful work and service for God but also to mentor, disciple, and raise those who are faithful to carry on the faithful work of the LORD (2 Tim. 2:2). In doing God's Work, we are thus not to be lone rangers doing everything that we can, but to delegate and work in teams with others. When we fail to plan and anticipate for the carrying on of God's Work by the faithful hands of the next generation, it would surely end with us. We are to ensure as Charles Wesley says, "God buries His workmen but carries on His work".

May we receive the commendation from our LORD and Saviour Jesus as His faithful servants (Matt. 25:21, 23).
