"Oneness in Christ"

Pastor Simon N.. Lord's Dav. 2 January 2022

Blessed New Year Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Isn't it amazing how God has seen us all through another roller coaster year-2021? This year, we will focus on building a closer bond within our community of believers. With God enabling us, we become one people with one purpose and one goal. Paul gives the origin of our oneness clearly in Eph 4:4-6, "There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, Who is above all, and through all, and in you all." We are one – in Christ.

The Church, composed of sinners who became saints in Christ, and stepped forth as servants of Jesus. There are no geographical, ethnic or racial distinctions. No Gentile, Jewish. male, female, slave or freeman in the body of Christ [Gal 3:28]. There is but one Spirit, the Holy Spirit, which indwells each believer, unifying the body of Christ. Believers are also united by the one hope; the hope of seeing the glorious appearing of our Great God and Saviour Jesus Christ [Titus 2:13] and of sharing the glory with Him [1 Jn 3:2, Col 1:23, 27]. We have one Lord and "one faith" in our Saviour Jesus Christ [Acts 4:12] — Who is the focus of our belief. Because of our "one faith", we participate in one baptism. Last, but not least, we share the same paternity. Despite our individual "uniqueness", we have the same Heavenly Father. We are brothers and sisters in Christ. In short, our bond is eternal and unbreakable. Sometimes the body of Christ, the Church, finds herself embroiled in issues that threaten the peace and harmony in the Church. What steps could believers take to protect and build the unity of the Church?

Focus on the Messiah

Paul in his epistles to the brethren who were facing difficult situations where the issues

threatened to undermine the unity of the Church, drew their attention back to the One on Whom their devotion and true allegiance must lie – the Lord Jesus Christ [Phil 4:2-5].

What happens when the body of Christ loses sight of the Saviour? Firstly, our eyes will look at people. We will tend to get personal and miss the issues at hand. Secondly, we will get "sucked" into the problems and never surface to see any light. Worse it is when we digress into unrelated matters, become petty or historical. Thirdly, we may shift our priorities, away from the vital issues. Somehow in all this mess and confusion, person or persons become the focus of our attention and we miss the point altogether. Let us remind ourselves not to set any person on a pedestal. We need only to look "unto Jesus the Author and Finisher of our faith" [Heb 12:2].

Focus on the Mission

The Lord called us to proclaim the Gospel, make disciples and build the Body of Christ-[Mt 28:19]. In the year 2022, our church focuses on the SSG (small Support Group) ministry. The church leaders prayerfully desire Galileans to take an interest to join in one of the groups that are suitable and grow in it. The former Fellowship Group design in this new arrangement will serve to provide age grouping and periodical gathering of all SSGs under the respective fellowship "umbrellas" for combined meetings. The SSG will become the doorway to newcomers and new converts who will eventually immerse into the membership of the Church

Brethren, in all things, unitedly, as one body in Christ, one people, one Church family, humbly seeking to extend God's Kingdom and to glorify the Lord's Name in and through the avenues that God has provided us. Let us encourage and exhort one another to serve the Risen Lord with all our soul, strength and mind. May God help us!

NORTH VIETNAM-SINGAPORE VIRTUAL CHILDREN'S CAMP 3 DECEMBER 2021

Thank God for the vision of a group of young and old to run a Virtual Children's Camp for the children of Shalom International Academy (SIA), in North Vietnam. This is our first Virtual Children's Camp with an overseas audience since the Covid-19 pandemic started.

The Camp theme was "The Armor of God". The program included Praise and Worship, and Bible Story using puppets. There were quizzes, action songs, charade (game), prayer time and photo taking. The children were given worksheets to answer questions on the lessons learned. A booklet with pointers on how to pray and what to pray was given to each student to encourage them to record their prayer requests in their Prayer Journal.

The SIA students were very attentive, enthusiastic and participated very well in the activities in the program. During this camp, the students also learned new English Children's songs. There were some children whose parents are non-believers and these children requested prayers for their parents' salvation. At the end of the program the children were rewarded with prizes for their participation.

The Singapore team is very happy that they could run this program with the assistance of the Vietnamese teachers. For future Virtual Camps, the team would like to incorporate more of our favorite Children's songs and to break-up the children into smaller groups for discussion on lessons learned.

The Missions Committee noted that the gospel could be shared through this channel and would like to thank the following team members for their valued contributions in making this Virtual Camp a success. A big thank you also to members who prayed that that this camp will work out well. All Glory To Our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.
