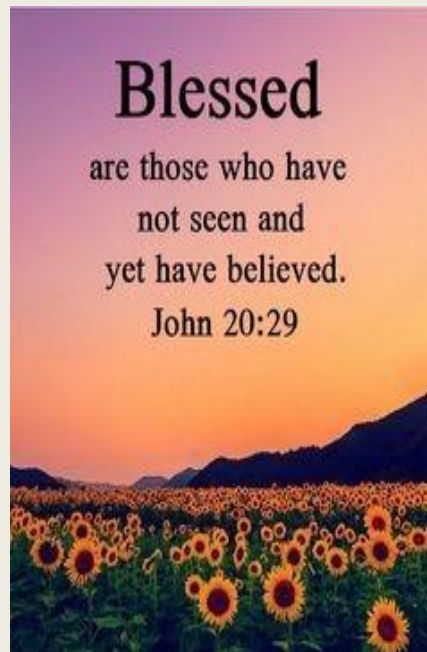

God's Sustaining Grace

Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 9 January 2022

Beloved Brethren,

Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. When we look back on the past year of 2021 and the challenges and struggles that we have managed to go through, we are reminded of God's grace, not only His saving grace (Eph. 2:8-9) but also His continuing and sustaining grace (Phil. 1:6).

This sustaining grace has surely helped us go through and overcome the difficulties and temptations in our lives. The Apostle Paul also experienced this with the thorn in his flesh which he asked God three times to remove from him (2 Cor. 12:7-8). However, God did not remove this thorn from Paul's life but instead encouraged Paul that His grace, strength, and power are with him especially during his tough times and times of weakness. This same encouragement is also given to us during such times in our lives.

When we have God's sustaining grace in our lives, we would first be able to overcome the trials and temptations that come our way (1 Cor. 10:13 "There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it"). Secondly, we would realise that we should not depend on our human strength and capabilities, but instead depend on God to keep us going for Him (Isaiah 41:10 "Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee;

yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness").

Thirdly, God's sustaining grace will ensure that we would come out of life's challenges with our faith in God much stronger (1 Peter 1:7 "That the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ").

Knowing that God's sustaining grace is always available to us as it was to the Apostle Paul, how then are we able to have access to it? There are 2 main ways that we can do so.

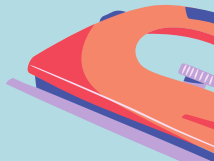
Firstly, we will need to have our primary focus on God and His Word so that they can direct our paths in all seasons of our lives, especially the difficult and tough-going ones (Psalm 119:105 "Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path"). We would also be comforted and encouraged by the enduring promises in His Word. This would ensure that our focus is on God who is permanent and unshifting in our lives, which would help us to stand firm on Him.

Next, we will also need to pray and seek God's sustaining grace and power in our lives (Heb. 4:16 "Let us, therefore, come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need"). When we do so, we would be drawing close to God and experiencing His Presence in our lives.

Let us commit to living lives that are filled with God's saving and sustaining grace.
