"I can do all things through Christ..."

Pastor Simon N, Lord's Day, 16 January 2022

Brethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ! There is an attitude running viral in the Christian body of believers. We can perhaps call it an infection of the "I can't" virus, an attitude of doubt and disbelief, which is tantamount to a lack of trust and faith in God. Brethren, let us take heed. This attitude would have us believe that we are worthless, lacking and incapable and that we can never do anything worthy and useful in the Kingdom of God. A

person's upbringing and unfortunate experiences play a crucial part in shaping such an attitude.

The inspiring words of the Apostle Paul to the Philippian Christians, "I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me" (Phil 4:13), would serve well as an effective antidote to destroy this virulent "I can't" virus. This mindset removes spiritual ailment and

restores health, vitality and zeal in believers. Paul testified from personal experience of the enabling Power of God in his life: We can too! God looks at our availability and willingness, not so much our capability, for in whatever area[s] we lack, the Lord will richly supply. God wants us to offer ourselves for service and depend on Him to help us. Let us stop the influence of the "I can't" virus that undermines our walk with the Lord and our service for Him. The question is: "How do we vaccinate against this "I can't" virus"?

We need to recognize that our ultimate all-in-all strength is found in God, and God alone. Our Lord Jesus said: "I am the Vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in Me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without Me ye can do nothing" (Jhn 15:5). Apart from God, we can do nothing of heavenly worth. We need to "plug" into the Ultimate Power Source, our Lord Jesus Christ, and be constantly "charged" to do His Perfect Will and accomplish the tasks He puts into our hands.

King David's help in life was from the Lord and he testified confidently: "The LORD is my Strength and my Shield; my heart trusted in Him, and I am helped: therefore, my heart greatly rejoiceth; and with my song will I praise Him" (Ps 28:7).

Brethren, the Lord God is also our Strength and very Help. Praise be to God! We can succumb easily to this "I can't" virus when intense challenges engulf us. When negative feedback and

discouraging remarks infiltrate our minds; we fret in fear and doubt, overwhelmed by the big looming problems facing us, our vision will shift from Jesus to the problem. Here again, David's example serves us well. In turbulent times, constantly he re-aligned himself with God. "The LORD is my Rock, and my Fortress, and my Deliverer; my God, my Strength, in Whom I will trust; my Buckler, and the Horn of my salvation, and my High

Tower" (Ps 18:2).

Brethren, fear and anxiety are lethal weapons of our "spiritual" enemy. But, "God hath not given us the spirit of fear: but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind" (2Tim 1:7). We must exercise faith in God that He will empower us to accomplish well the tasks He has for us. We read in the Bible... how God empowered and transformed His humble servants to become "spiritual giants"... when they obeyed God's call and submitted themselves to be moulded by the Potter. These ordinary "vessels" transformed to accomplish feats themselves. Joseph was imprisoned on a false charge but rose to the highest office in Egypt, little slave-baby Moses grew to be the strong champion of the Exodus; shepherd-lad David was the mighty slaver of Goliath: captive Daniel became the topmost civil servant in mighty Babylon and unbelieving Saul into the Apostle Paul. Brethren, God will enable you and I to be profitable servants in the Kingdom of God when we respond in faith and humility: "I can, God helping me". God bless!
