Blessed Lunar New Year greetings in Christ Jesus our Lord! This year again, our customary visitations required some careful planning playing by the rules and staying safe. We

pray that this pandemic will subside and a new promising future emerges to the delight and relief of everyone.

Praise and thank God for members added to our community of believers. We confidently and gratefully acknowledge that it is "God... that giveth the increase" (1 <u>Cor 3:7).</u> On our part, let us give an invitation to the people we know to

come to our church. Prov 18:24 exhorts: "A man that hath friends must shew himself friendly ... " In some churches, newcomers to Sunday Worship Service are introduced as guests rather than visitors. The feeling is different, isn't it? Perhaps, they see welcoming a quest to be "warmer" and more personal. Brethren, we can have the most beautiful sanctuary, the best church facilities and amenities, the most inspiring sermons, the greatest choral and musical accompaniment, a very neatlooking worshipper profile.... but what [apart from the solid ministry of the Word of God from the pulpit] will really edge a memorable Sunday Worship in the hearts of our visitors and encourage them to come again to Galilee, is that they feel the warm fellowship in a caring and loving community of faith here. I am reminded of how the Lord blessed the Early Christians as they gathered regularly for worship and fellowship: "Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved" (Acts 2:47).

Our Lord Jesus said, "By this shall all men know that ye are My disciples if ye have love one to another" (Jn 13:35). We are the "ambassadors for Christ" (2 Cor 5:20). I praise the Lord for a caring and loving community of faith at Galilee. Thank God for our Fellowship groups, SSG, Sunday lunch groups meeting at venues outside our premises, Bible Study groups, to name but a few, have been serving our Lord well as "conduits" of Christ's love and care for one another. God has been good to building a strong and closely-knit church family at Galilee. Praise the

"Be not forgetful to entertain strangers: for thereby some have entertained angels unawares" Hebrews 13:2 Lord! It is because we love our very own, that we can extend ourselves to reach out with the love of Christ to touch the hearts of our visitors and bring them into the loving fold of our Lord. In our zeal to reach out to our visitors, we need to be sensitive to our visitors being "comfortable" in their pace to fit in among us. And as the Lord leads and as He gives the opportunity, let us gently share the Gospel. By the grace of God, we are already doing well in all these areas but we must always strive to do better.

It has been observed that <u>more people have</u> <u>been brought into the church by the warm lovingkindness of Christians than by all the theological</u> <u>arguments in the world</u>, and more people have been driven from the church by the hardness and ugliness of Christians they worship God with on the Lord's Day. Brethren, may the Lord help Galilee to be not only a God-focused and God-honouring church but also a people-caring-warm church, where believers and friends find it a joy even to drive halfway across our island to worship with us as a community of believers again, and again. Let us all keep up the good work.
