

### "We Are Always On God's Mind"

Pastor Simon N., Lord's Day, 20 Feb 2022

Brethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. Thank God for His mercies and grace upon us. Have you had moments where you wonder to yourself, is there anyone out there who care enough to think of you? It can be discouraging if the answer isn't promising. Cheer-up brethren, reading Ps 40:5, we are informed how much God thinks about us, His preciously redeemed people. The Psalmist declares that God's thoughts toward us are innumerable, too many to be counted or

numbered. The Lord loves His people so much that He cannot keep Himself from thinking about us. We are always on His mind. Isn't that comforting to know? The Psalmist was deeply touched: "How precious also are Thy

thoughts unto me, O God! how great is the sum of them!" (Ps 139:17). "But I am poor and needy; yet the Lord thinketh upon me: Thou art my Help and my Deliverer; make no tarrying, O my God" (40:17).

God knows and understands us and every aspect of our daily lives. He knows what goes on in our lives, to the minutest detail. God knows the trials. heartaches, confusion, sickness, and pain many faces. Our Lord Jesus Christ intercedes on our behalf constantly before God. God continually guides and intervenes so that all things in our lives will work together for our good (Rom 8:28) as we trust Him. May God help us not be discouraged when our circumstances seem bleak and difficult to bear. We must believe that God's ways are not our ways; His ways are higher than ours. He holds the future in His hands. God's Will is perfect and suitable for His beloved children (Isa 55:9). We must continue to seek God and ask for His grace and strength to see us through the hard times of our lives. Hard times help us to mature spiritually in Christ.

"For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end" (Jer 29:11). God's thoughts toward us are tender thoughts of peace and not of evil. He does not sit in Heaven and think of ways to constantly "punish" us because of our misdeeds. His thoughts toward us are thoughts of peace and thoughts of love for our good and blessedness. His thoughts are toward living an abundant life in Jesus Christ and more excellent service in His Kingdom.

"Many, O LORD my God, are Thy wonderful works which Thou hast done, and <u>Thy thoughts which are to us-ward</u>: they cannot be reckoned up in order unto Thee: if I would declare and speak of them, they are more than can be numbered" (Ps 40:5)

God's thoughts for us are filled with peace. Shouldn't we also experience that same peace in our minds when we think about God? Our Lord Jesus Christ is the Prince of Peace. The Body

of Christ ought to learn how to have "peace" -peace with God, peace within self and harmony
with one another. Money cannot buy us peace of
mind. It is sad when we allow the Enemy to rob us
of the peace we so desperately need because we
have not fully understood God's thoughts and are
unwilling to follow God's ways and direction for
our lives. God wants to bless His people with a
peace that surpasses all understanding. When we
have a close and personal relationship with God,
we will see things that we cannot see apart from
Him. When we are "connected" to God, we will
experience His peace and His magnificent glory in
our lives.

Brethren, no matter what "happens" to us in life, the Word of God assures us that God is for us, not against us. God has a plan and an eternal destiny for His people. He will see to it that His plan will come to pass according to His purposes and in His good time. Meanwhile, let us, His good children, continue to abide in Him, to trust Him, serve Him and be grateful that we are in His thoughts constantly. God Bless!
