GO...AND TEACH ALL NATIONS!

Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 6 March 2022

B Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. Our Lord Jesus gave the Great Commission to His disciples, which applies to us, to be occupied till He returns. Jesus said, "Go ye therefore and teach all nations, baptising them in the Name of the Father, and the Son, and of the Holy Ghost" Matt 28:19.

Yes, today is our Missions Sunday. When our Lord gave the charge "Go" firstly, the element of urgency is in it. Hurry! Get the Gospel out! We are not to be contented in "Jerusalem" alone but bravely cross masses of lands and seas with the Good News of salvation for humanity. The ongoing Conflicts, Climate and COVID only amplify the urgency. The Lord's return is ever nearer; His disciples expected to act on the command earnestly.

Next, to bring the Gospel unwaveringly, not only in favourable times but also in challenging times. Countless God-fearing missionaries had taken the Great Commission seriously. They weathered hard times for the sake of the Gospel. They endured lack or loss of possessions, minimal comfort and inconsistent of necessities. harsh cultural supply mistreatments, and indefinite personal safety. Though we need to be wise as serpents and harmless as doves (Matt 10:16), nevertheless, we persistently plan to visit our mission stations and serve alongside our foreign brethren. The Lord decides, and we deliver accordingly in His strength.

Lastly, the Lord instructs us to go to "all nations."

In other words, we will go without personal preferences or prejudices towards any nation. Our reasonable response is to go where He leads and do well when our Lord opens the door. Some years ago, I was very reluctant to go to Kenya. Pastor Musyoki invited me several times. I had a "mental block" towards Kenya. I formed an imagination that Kenyan men and women are temperamental and quick to wield their machetes. I feared for my safety and decided to avoid going to Kenya. Thank God, at some point, my fear turned to faith; I embraced all subsequent opportunities delightfully and regarded them as God-given opportunities to minister amongst the Kenyan brethren.

Since the first quarter of 2020, all mission trips have been postponed because of the COVID-19 pandemic. What about this year? Will things improve for us to visit the brethren in our various mission stations to enjoy mutual encouragement and fellowship with one another? God willing, the missions committee is looking at the possibility of visiting our brethren in Kenya during the fourth quarter of this year. Rev Richard has planned some important church events. Let's watch and pray!

Thankfully, our Galileans are resourceful. With the help of technology, a team of committed Galileans worked tediously to conduct Online Children Camp in North Vietnam on 3rd December 2021. This year, Online or Onsite, we will do our part in mission work. Encourage our brethren in God's Word, equip Church leaders with skills and knowledge and labour together for the glory of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. God Bless!
