STAY ON FIRE FOR GOD'S WORK

Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 27 Mar 2022

Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

As God's ambassadors on earth, we are responsible for bringing the Gospel message of hope and reconciliation between the Holy God and sinful humankind (2 Cor. 5:18-21). Though the goal of this mission is simple enough, why do some of us at times not have the motivation and drive to accomplish and fulfil it?

One, it could be that **our hearts are more self-centered and focused on our personal and familial needs and concerns** rather than on the eternal and spiritual needs. We are not merely saved and called by God to be satisfied with ourselves being on the pathway to Heaven, but we are to spread the Gospel message to bring others into the Kingdom of God. In doing so, we would do well to remind ourselves of the great sacrifice that Christ went through on the Cross for our sins and extend this same sacrificial attitude and mindset into the lives of others. We would then not be distracted from and be motivated and encouraged by the great need and urgency to save souls (Prov. 11:30).

Two, even though the goal of God's mission to save souls is straightforward, it still needs us to have **the full-hearted commitment of ensuring the wholeness of our Christian character and being**. It is essential and needful that while we are sharing the Gospel message with others, the same elements of a believer is reflected in our entire interaction with them and evidenced in our work, study, and other social environments. Our lifestyle should show consistency, whether in the secular world or church. God has called and placed us as His ambassadors and witnesses for Him in this world.

Lastly, **our faithful Christian witness and work for Him can result in us experiencing the "fires" of rejection, persecution, and suffering brought about by others** (2 Tim. 3:12 "Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution"). We need not be fearful of such temporal and momentary suffering that we become hesitant in putting forth our total commitment and energy into the things of God, His Gospel, His Kingdom, and His purposes. We need to remind ourselves of the eternal and glorious nature of the spiritual things of God, which would far outweigh and outrange those of the world (2 Cor. 4:17; 1 Peter 3:14). Such faithful witness and work for God would reflect our true faith, trust and dependence in God and would also result in our growing faith in God (1 Peter 5:10).

Not only is God's work to be done by each of us as individual Christians, but we together as members of the same local body of Christ are to motivate one another to do and fulfil God's work with the different gifts and talents that each of us has (Romans 12:3-8; 1 Cor. 12:4-13, 27-31; Eph. 4:4-13; James 1:17).

Let us together press on and keep our hearts burning for the Lord's Work (1 Cor. 15:58 "Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye steadfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord").
