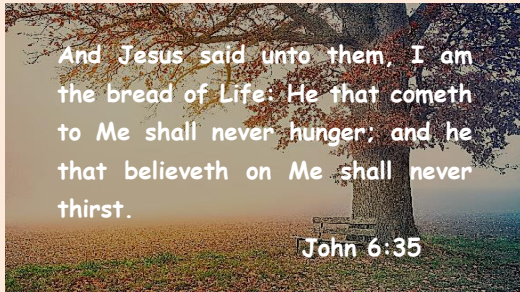

“Labour In the Lord”

Pastor Simon N., Lord's Day, 1 May 2022

Brethren,

Labour Day Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ! Besides a day of rest, Labour Day is also a time to respect and recognise everyone's effort in nation-building. These exemplary men and women serve as role models for the next generation. May the Lord bless our city-state and nation builders in every industry.

In God's Kingdom, a vast population of His servants toil hard to advance the purposes and goals of our Lord Jesus Christ. The work is hard, challenges are tall, problems are complex, and obstacles are numerous, but the goal of our collaborative labour is crucial in God's work. Gospel outreach and build believers in the faith.

Our predecessors in the faith set a high benchmark for us to emulate in our service to God. Today, we are building on the work they have toiled diligently and privileged us to carry on their excellent work. They have done well amidst challenges; now, the baton is in our hands. We must hold tight and race with focus and commit to the hands of the next generation. Succession! The work must flow from one generation to the next without compromising the faith and doctrine of the Bible. How do we do that properly and effectively? The Psalmist answers aptly, “One generation shall praise thy works to another and shall declare thy Mighty Acts” Ps 145:4.
