PALM SUNDAY

Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 10 Apr 2022

Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

Today, we are celebrating Palm Sunday at the very start of the Holy Week. On this very Palm Sunday more than 2000 years ago, the Jews were waving the palm branches in their hands as well as laying them and their cloaks across the road that Jesus passed by into Jerusalem. They also raised their joyous voices singing: **“Blessed is He that cometh in the Name of the Lord; Hosanna in the Highest!”** (Matt. 21:9) to welcome Jesus as He sat on a colt or young male horse. They greatly anticipated Him as their Victorious King Who would overthrow and deliver them from the heavy burden of bondage and oppression of the Romans.

As the Jewish crowd welcomed Jesus into Jerusalem though with the wrong impressions and intentions, are we similarly welcoming and not rejecting Jesus from coming into our hearts? There are constantly many responsibilities and needs that call for our attention and time. As a result, we often miss out on the rest and renewed strength that can be found in the Presence of God (Ps. 27:1-3).

Jesus, instead of riding high on a majestic and glorious chariot drawn by a strong and mighty steed or a strong horse, chose to ride on a lowly colt. This surely reminds us of the humility of Christ when He chose to come down from His position as the Son of God in Heaven to enter our world in the form of a human being to die for our sins (Phil. 2:5-11). It is only when we follow the example of Christ in being humble that we can make progress in our Christian living (James 4:6-8, 10). In doing so, we would not fall into the sin of self-sufficiency, but have the willingness to cast our burdens and weights

to our LORD for Him to bear them for us (Ps. 55:22).

Even after Jesus triumphantly entered and was joyously welcomed into Jerusalem, it did not last, and less than a week later, He was betrayed by one of His disciples, abandoned even by His disciples, arrested and falsely tried, being spat at and slapped, whipped, mocked, crowned with thorns, and eventually suffered His eventual death on the Cross. This sudden and tragic turn of events in the life of Christ is also reflective of our Christian lives with its expected and unexpected ups and downs, and twists and turns.

But how do we respond appropriately to such highs and lows of our lives? As Christ sought His Father thrice to take away the Cup of Suffering from Him (Matt. 26:36-44), and the Apostle Paul also asked thrice for God to take away the thorn in his flesh (2 Cor. 12:7-8), they were still determined to press on in their submission to God's Will and purposes for them. When we find our human spirit, strengths, and abilities failing us in certain situations, it is only God and His grace that can bring us through all seasons of our lives (2 Cor. 12:9-10). Do we trust and depend on God, or do we question and doubt God for every new difficulty and hardship that we meet with?

Let us remain steadfast and committed to following Christ not only in our good times, but also in our bad times. We must thus be always prepared to take up our cross and follow Christ (Matt. 16:24; Luke 9:23), receiving God's commendation of our faithfulness to Him (Matt. 25:21, 23).
